- Feb. 9, 1700 Birth of Daniel Bernoulli, physicist of the theory of fluids.
- Feb. 11, 1839 Birth of Josiah Willard Gibbs, Yale professor of mathematics who developed the laws of thermodynamics and the theory of statistical mechanics.
- Feb. 12, 1785 Birth of Pierre Dulong, who worked with Alexis Berthollet in 1809 to determine the atomic weights of the elements.
- Feb. 17, 1838 Birth of Frederick Soddy, the discoverer of the concept of isotopes.
- Feb. 19, 1859 Birth of Svante Arrhenius, Swedish chemist who developed the theory of electrolytic dissociation.

Your letter dated June 13, 1973 concerning the FBI's investigation of the crash landing of a United Airlines Boeing 737 at New York is being reviewed.
