Dated 21 Cornhill Aug 29th to
Caroline Weston

"This morning I have come over
to the office & am writing here
waiting for Mr Taft & Edmund
Brown has just come in and
reported a great mob at Norwich
Their Convention was broken up
the mob headed by church members,
does not think there has been such
a mob since 1835 - Foster's coat
was torn completely off his back
but Mrs Merian who was down
there sewed it up."
