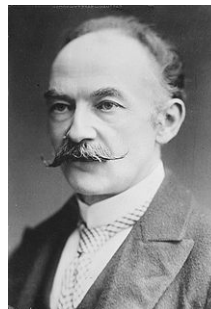
FAR FROM THE MADDING CROWD
