and while I'm busy recommending, any of you who haven't been following the arts ejournal I edit for the Walker Art Center (mnartists.org) should start!

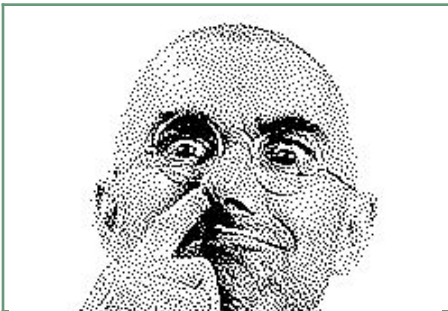

Word on a new Blog 'zine project comes to us from Kamen Nedev who has posted more information on his Blog at <http://emitmedia.blogspot.com/>

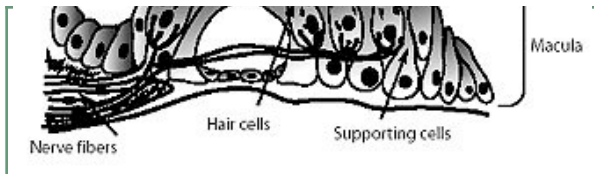
Kamen begins;

...Recently, a post to the Wrying-L list announced the appearance of a new e-zine of new media writing and experimental poetry: Otoliths.

In the words of its editor, Mark Young,

It'll be called Otoliths. Why? Because I like the word. & its definition. An otolith is one of the small bones or particles of calcareous or other hard substance in the internal ear of vertebrates, and in the auditory organs of many invertebrates; an ear stone. Collectively, the otoliths are called ear sand and otoconite.

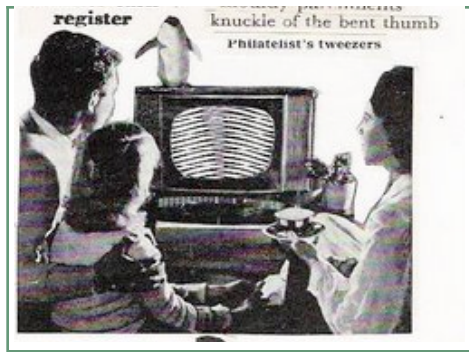
