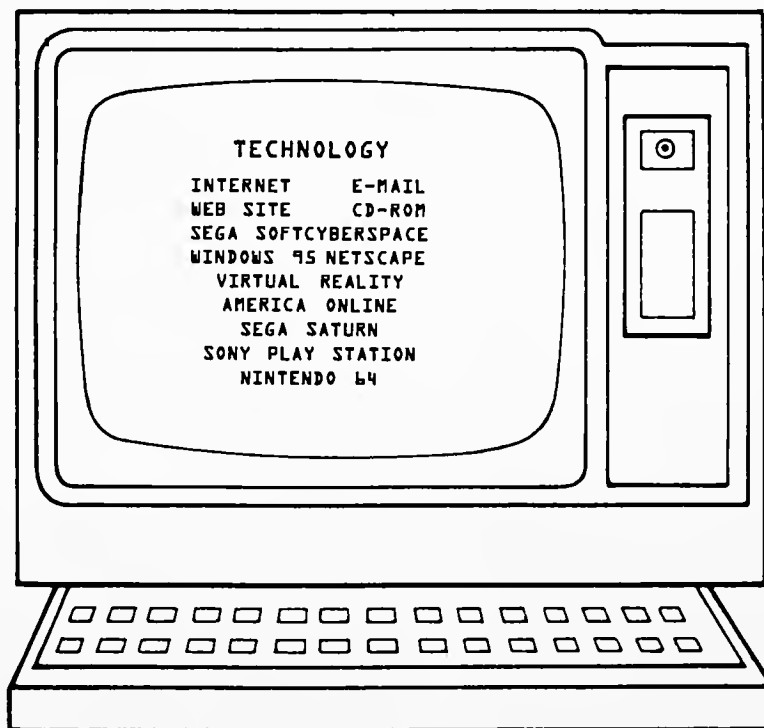
MOVIE CRAZE!

Every evening I looked to her sitting there at her computer, working with such total dedication, struggling in deep pursuit, searching for the honest truth, reaching for the final destination.

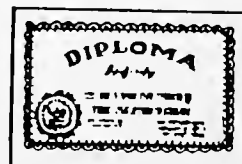
