Published in 1920, it includes a number of stories relating to the inhabitants of the fictional Canadian village of Avonlea and its region, located on Prince Edward Island.</p> <p>The book was published without the permission of L. M. Montgomery, and was formed from stories she had decided not to publish in the earlier <i>Chronicles of Avonlea</i>. Montgomery sued her publishers, L. C.
