Genealogical Memoranda

OF THE

FAMILY OF WORDSWORTH.

It is scarcely possible to refer to any deed of the period between the latter half of the fourteenth century and the beginning of the eighteenth century, which related to property or to ecclesiastical or civil matters in the parish of Penistone, without coming across the name of some member of the family of Wordsworth, either as principal or witness.

The name was variously spelt—Wurdesworth, Wadysworth, Wadesworth, Wadisworth, Wordesworth, Wordsworth, Wordsworth, Wordsworth, Wordsworth, Wordsworth, Wordsworth, and Wordsworth. Some branches of the family at the present time spell the name Wadsworth, and others Wordsworth, the latter being the more general form.

The family seems to have been entirely a Yorkshire one, and first appears, during the reign of Edward III., to be located at Penistone. The earliest deed in which the name occurs is dated 1392, when one Nicholas Wurdesworth appears as one of the witnesses to the same.

This Nicholas is, in all probability, the one mentioned in the inscription on the "greate arke," of which an account is to be found in Dr. C. Wordsworth's 'Life of Wordsworth,' and respecting the interesting search for, and recovery of which old almoury, extracts of letters written by Dr. Hunter to Gamaliel Milner, Esq., of Thurlstone, and to the 'Gentleman's Magazine' of July, 1850, are to be found published in Mr. J. Wilkinson's 'History of Worsborough.'

It may be as well, here, to mention that one of the family of Wordsworth, in the reign of Henry VIII., adopted a curious, but, as it proved, secure method of recording several generations of his immediate ancestors. A William Wordesworth, in 1525, caused to be made an oaken ark or chest, on which he placed the following inscription, carrying his descent back four generations from himself:—

"Hoc op. fiebat A° D'ni M°CCCCCC° XXV° ex su'pta Will'mi Wordesworth, filii

"Hoc op. fiebat A° D'ni M°CCCCC° XXV° ex su'pta Will'mi Wordesworth, filii W., fil. Joh., fil. W., fil. Nich., viri Elizabeth filiæ et hered. W. Proctor de Peniston q°ru ani'abus p'picietur De.' (Surtees Soc., vol. iv.)

In a deed dated May 20th, 1430, we find a William Wordesworth as a witness.

In a deed dated May 20th, 1430, we find a William Wordesworth as a witness. This was a deed of John del Rodes, Custos Capellæ Sancti Johannis apud Penystonii, and there is great probability that this William was the son of Nicholas named in the inscription on the oak chest.

We have next record of William Wordsworth, vicar of Penistone, who succeeded Robert Polyn as vicar, and was legatee in his will dated Feb. 27th, 1458, at which period a John Wordsworth was living at Water Hall, the old residence of the family for a very considerable period.

"Item. There is in the hands of Robert Hawkesworth, of Cawthorne Lanes, twenty pounds given yearly by Parson Bilcliffe and Alderman Micklethwaith, to pay to the poore of Peniston for the same yearly on St. Thomas Day, twenty shillings. Assurance for this 20¹¹ is in the hands of Ralph Wordsworth, Anno Dom. 1640."

"Item. Given by John Wordsworth, late of Water Hall, three shillings yearly for ever to be dealt to six of the most needfull poore within Peniston, and is to be dealt yearly by Ralph Wordsworth and his successors on St. Thomas' Day." [This is not dated).

On the 26th Sept., 1650, Priscilla, daughter of William Wordsworth of Fal-

thwaite, gent. (and sister of Thomas Wordsworth, of Doncaster, gent.) was married to Henry Rayney of Tyers Hill, gent. Thomas Wordsworth of Doncaster was a grocer; he died in 1667, aged 35 years. (Hunter's 'South Yorkshire,' vol. ii., p. 121.)

On the 18th Oct., 1656, Josias Wordsworth of Water Hall, gent., married Sarah,

daughter of George Beaumont of the Oakes, Darton.

Dec. 23rd, 1663. Indentures between William Wordsworth, Falthwaite, on the one part, and Samuel Savile of Mexbro', gent., and Thomas Norton of Spout House, gent., on the other part. Whereas Francis Morton of Wraith House and Grace his wife (late wife of William Wordsworth, deceased), and Richard Wordsworth, infant, by the said Francis Morton his guardian, and grandchild of the aforesaid William Wordsworth, obtained a decree in Chancery on November 18th last past, against said William Wordsworth, Richard Leake, and Mary Armitage, that they should convey land to the use of said Richard Wordsworth, a former deed to that purpose having been lost in the Civil Wars, William Wordsworth now conveys to the said Richard, his grandson, lands at Falthwaite, etc.

April 10th, 1665. Will of William Wordsworth of Falthwaite, gent., wishes to be buried at Silkstone with his predecessors. Leaves to his daughter, Priscilla Rayney, three closes in Barnsley; to son Thomas, a messuage in Barnsley, etc.; to daughter, Susan Bingley, £10 over her marriage portion; to his grandchild, Mary Cross, £5; mentions sister Dorothy Woodhead, cousins Elizabeth, Francis York, his brother Lionel Wordsworth's daughter's child, cousins Gervas, Ann and George

Woodhead, cousin Mary Tilney. Son Thomas to be executor.

The name of Tilney is retained to this day, members named Tilney Wordsworth

are living at Penistone and at Leeds at the present time.

Sept. 3rd, 1666. William Wordsworth, Falthwaite, gent., makes his trusty and well beloved friend John Wordsworth, Swaithe House, gent., Ambrose Wordsworth, Schole Hill, gent., and Henry Rayney of Darfield, gent., his attornies to do certain

In the will, dated Oct. 29th, 1673, of William Rich of Hornthwaite, yeoman,

mention is made of Josias Wordsworth of Water Hall.

In the 29th Charles II. Josiah Wordsworth, Godfrey Bosville, Sylvanus Riche, William Beever, Francis Morton, and George Walker are trustees of the Free Grammar School of Penistone, and in 1677 they are again named as the feoffees.

In 1693 a Richard Wordsworth, of Normanton, sold land at Wraith House which belonged to the Wordsworths of Falthwaite. (See letter of Dr. Hunter's, dated Nov. 23rd, 1831.)

1710. Gregory Wordsworth is allowed to join the Gravels and his house in town together, for the town allowed Thomas Roebuck to joyn the upper house to the house where he dwells.

The marriage settlement of Josias Wordsworth the elder is dated 27th Oct., 1721.

In the will of Josias Wordsworth, dated April 12th, 1732, of the parish of St.

Dunstan's in the East, London, is the following passage:-

"I give to Penistone, in Yorkshire, for teaching poor girls to read and work, Two Hundred Pounds, to be laid out in land or lett out to interest and the annual produce applied to that purpose, and that the Trustees appointed under my brother's charity be the Trustees of this." Rest to Josias Wordsworth, son of his brother

An abstract of deeds referring to the Schole Hill property, dated Nov. 9th, 1733, shews that lands at Schole Hill had been willed to Phineas Wordsworth by John Wordsworth his father.

To a document, relating to parish business, dated April ye 19th, 1733, we find the signatures of Phin. Wordsworth, John Wordsworth, Jonn Wordsworth, and John Wordsworth, cum aliis.

On the 12th April, 1737, H. Bosville, John Wordsworth, and William Fenton signed an agreement on behalf of the parish of Penistone and by general consent

of the parishioners.

In the will of Josias Wordsworth, dated Feby 2nd and 3rd, 1748, he mentions Mary his wife, Josias Wordsworth the younger (eldest son and heir apparent), Ann Robinson of Hull, spinster, Samuel Wordsworth of London, Esquire, and Robert Nettleton of London, Esquire.

On the title page of a book, "The Great Importance of a Religious Life Considered," now in the possession of Mr. John Edward Wordsworth of Penistone,

"John Wordsworth's book, given by Sir Wm. Wentworth, Bart., 1756;" and on another page, "Susannah Wordsworth, her book, 1775."

In the will of Elias Wordsworth, dated January 14th, 1777, he leaves to his son John Wordsworth, of Penistone, one moiety of Schole Hill; rest to his son Elias; to his daughter Ann Stotfield (or Schofield) he leaves £50; and to his daughter Mary White, £50. Makes his son Elias sole executor.

Indentures of moiety of Schole Hill. Diana Wordsworth, of Penistone, widow of John Wordsworth, late of Schole Hill, and John Wordsworth, grocer, of Penistone, eldest son and heir of above John Wordsworth (by Diana his wife), and Ann his wife. They mortgage Schole Hill to Thomas Smith, of Cawthorne.

The Gravels farmstead, another property of the family, was rebuilt in 1708, by Gregory Wordsworth, the then owner; he became possessed of it by his marriage with Ann, the widow of John Coldwell, in 1688. The place was again rebuilt in 1847, and a stone, taken from the old building, is now to be seen in the gable of the barn, bearing the following inscription :-

G. A. W. 1708.

(Gregory and Ann Wordsworth.)

In 1800, Elizabeth, widow of Elias Wordsworth of Gravels, married William Lockwood, of Penistone, and they borrowed £120 on the Gravels property

Shepherd's Castle, another estate formerly in the possession of the Wordsworths, was rebuilt in 1826, by Mr. Bosville, the owner, and was sold by him in 1831.

The present occupier, Mr. Charles Berry, has farmed the estate since 1831, and a few years ago he stated that he had found several stones near the house with carving upon them, from his description of which they would appear to have had cut on them the arms which the Wordsworths were known to have borne. tunately these stones had been broken up and used for building material.

Elias Wordsworth, son of Elias Wordsworth before mentioned (whose will was dated Jan. 14, 1777, and who died the following year), died 1800 s.p. His brother John had a son Elias, who married a daughter of William Atkinson of Langsett, yeoman, but died s.p.; his widow it was who married the abovenamed William

Lockwood in 1800.

The Gravels remained in the possession of Lockwood until 1847, when he sold it

to Samuel Coward, Esq., of Penistone.

Amongst the Overseers of the Poor of Penistone, we find the following :- 1689, Jon^a Wordsworth; 1694, Josias Wordsworth; 1700, John Wordsworth; 1710, Godfrey Wordsworth; 1712, Jon. Wordsworth; 1719, Elias Wordsworth; 1733, Phineas Wordsworth; 1739, Jon. Wordsworth; 1744, Elias Wordsworth; 1762, Jon. Wordsworth; 1766, Elias Wordsworth; 1789, John Wordsworth, of Gravels.

On a tablet in the church at Penistone, in memory of the Charitable Benefactors to the parish, it is stated that Mr. Samuel Wordsworth of London, merchant, gave the sum of £500, which was disposed of in the purchase of an estate at Nether-

thong, parish of Almondbury.

The above notes are only fragmentary, and much of the information contained in them will be found in Dr. Hunter's 'South Yorkshire,' and in Dr. Wordsworth's 'Life of the Poet Laureate.' Attempts at a pedigree, connecting some of the different branches, have been made by the late Mr. C. H. Bedford of Penistone. It has been the object of the writer to make these more complete, and the annexed Pedigree is the result; doubtless, errors may have crept in with all the care taken to be as accurate as possible, it is, however, open to correction and addition, and, as far as it goes, may prove of interest to the numerous admirers of our distinguished and immortal northern Poet.

ADDENDA.

Since the above was written the following notes have been kindly communicated by Mr. W. J. Wordsworth of London, who has closely searched the Manuscripts, etc., in the British Museum and elsewhere for information respecting the family:—

In an assessment of the Poll tax made in 2 Richard II., in the West Riding of York, we find, at Penyston: "Ric. at Waterhall and Alice his wife." It seems very probable that this Richard may have been a Wordsworth. In the same assessment the names of "W^m Proctor and Joan his wife" occur.

At the same time is named "Robide Waddesworth," of Wadsworth, who was assessed at 12^d. From this it would appear that the family originally spring from Wadsworth, and that the Water Hall Wordsworths might be a branch descended from it.

The will of William Wordsworth, Vicar of Penistone, Jan. 12, 1494: "Willelmus Wordesworth, Vicarius eccl. par. de Penyston. Servitio B. M. de Penyston x* et imam vaccam optimam Willelmo Wordisworth de Snodinhill ij boves optimos. Thurstan Wordisworth fratri meo ij boves Fabricæ pontis qui vocatur Bulderbrig xiid Testibus Willelmo Wordisworth de Penyston." etc.

deacon, April 21, 1492, and priest. June 16, the same year.

In the will of "Nicholaus Wordesworth de Pennystone," dated Nov. 8, 1516, he names Margaret, Edward, and Nicholaus Wordesworth, John Burdett and William, John and Emma, his children, William and John, his sons, to be executors.

The following is from the will of John Wordsworth, parish of Penyston, Dec. 18, 1535: "To be buried in the churchyard of St. John Baptist of Penyston. To our Lady service ij. I have enfeoffed William Wordsworth, John Ryche, John Jenkinson and Richard Mykilwhet of my lands, etc., in Clayton to use of myself for life, remainder to William my son and his lawful heres; in defaulte to the use of our Lady service of Peneston and to be made as sure as the churchwardens or greiffes of the said Church can make it for ever. To Sir Thomas my son xx* William Wordsworth vi* viiid."

In a Chancery suit between Christopher Wilson of Broomhead and Thomas Barnby of Barnby, in 19 Eliz., 24 January (1579), a Thomas Wordsworth of Thurlston is one of the witnesses, and aged 55.

MONUMENTAL INSCRIPTIONS IN THE PARISH CHURCHYARD AT SILKSTONE.

Here lyeth the body of Joshua, the son of Robert Wordsworth of Thurgoland, died . . July, 1711, aged 24 years.

Here lieth interred the body of Robert Wordsworth of Thurgoland, died 6th September, 1747, aged 59 years.

(Inscription on upper part of tombstone not copied.)

Also Martha, daughter of the above John and Elizabeth Mokeson, and wife of John Wordsworth of Hermithill, in the Parish of Tankersley, died Nov. 14th 1764, aged 68 years.

Also the body of the abovesaid John Wordsworth, died 6th March, 1773, aged 88 years.

Here lieth the body of Benjamin Wordsworth of Stainborough fold, died 8th Dec. 1758, aged 71 years.

Also John Wordsworth of Stainborough foulds, died Jan. 12th 1793.






