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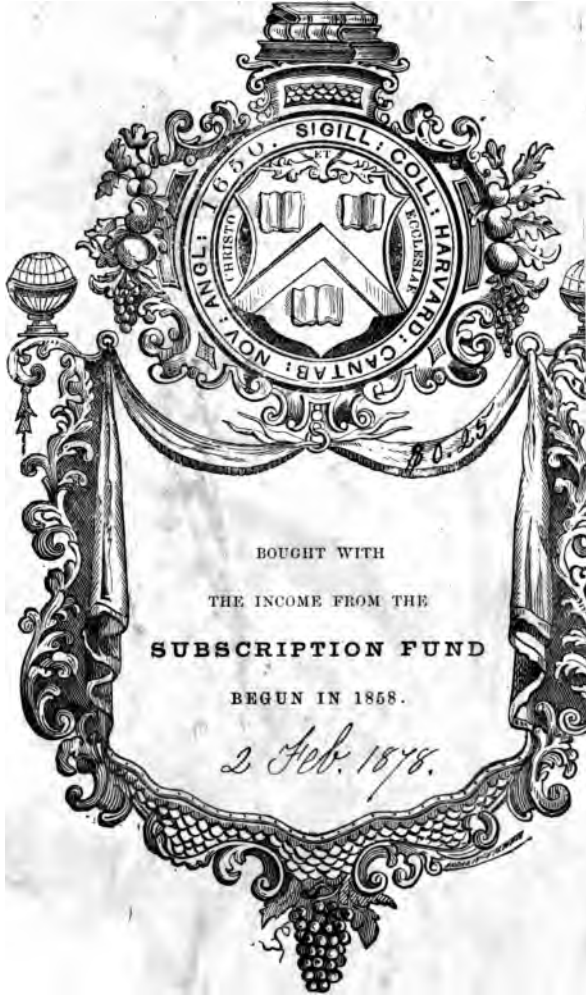
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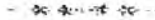

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FAMILY RECORD.

To "Savage's Genealogical Dictionary" I owe the possession of the following data of the early records of this branch of the Carpenter family.

1. WILLIAM.

William Carpenter came in the ship Bevis, 1638 from Southampton, England, aged 62; a carpenter from Horwell; settled in Weymouth, Mass.; was made freeman May 13, 1640; representative 1641 and '43, and died in the winter of 1659-60. His will of Dec. 10, names the following children: 2, John; 3, William; 4, Joseph; 5, Abijah; 6, Samuel; 7, Hannah; 8, Abigail.

3. WILLIAM.

William Carpenter son of William (1) born in England about 1605; came in the ship Bevis with his father in 1638, bringing his wife Abigail and four children, of whom we know the names of three. In 1643 he settled in Rehoboth, Mass., and acted as clerk for the proprietors until 1649. In 1643 he was chosen one of the deputies to the Plymouth Court, also in 1656. In 1653 and '55 he was chosen townsman, an office corresponding to that of selectman. His wife died Feb. 22, 1688. He died

His estate was valued at £254 10s.

10. WILLIAM.

William Carpenter, son of William (3) born in England, about 1632; came in the ship Bevis with his father and grandfather to Weymouth, Mass. in 1638; married 1st Oct. 5, 1651, Priscilla Bonett. She died in Oct. 1663, and he married 2d, Dec. 10, 1663, Miriam Searles, she born 1646. She died May 1 or 7,

1722. He was town clerk of Rehoboth, Mass. where he settled from 1668 with the exception of two years, until his death, which occurred Jan. 26, 1704.

Benjamin Carpenter, son of William (10) born Oct. 20, 1663; married March 4, 1691, Hannah, dau. of Jedediah Strong and Freedom Woodward, she born Feb. 3, 1671, in Northampton, Mass. He a farmer in Northampton, Mass., and after 1708 in Coventry, Conn. He died April 18, 1738, and his widow died March 20, 1762.

Captain Eliphalet Carpenter, son of Benjamin (19) born Nov. 29, 1703 in Northampton, Mass., and shortly after removed to Coventry, Conn. with his parents. He married 1st, 1727, Elizabeth, daughter of John Andrews and Hannah Gillett, she born in Hartford, Conn., Feb. 17, 1705-6, and died May 6, 1773. He married 2d, Oct. 26, 1775, Abigail Ladd, she died Capt. Carpenter died Feb. 22, 1792.

Of the above children, Hannah, Asahel, Abigail and Anna died within a few days of each other of the black throat distemper, that fearful scourge that carried death and consternation to so many families in Conn. about that time.

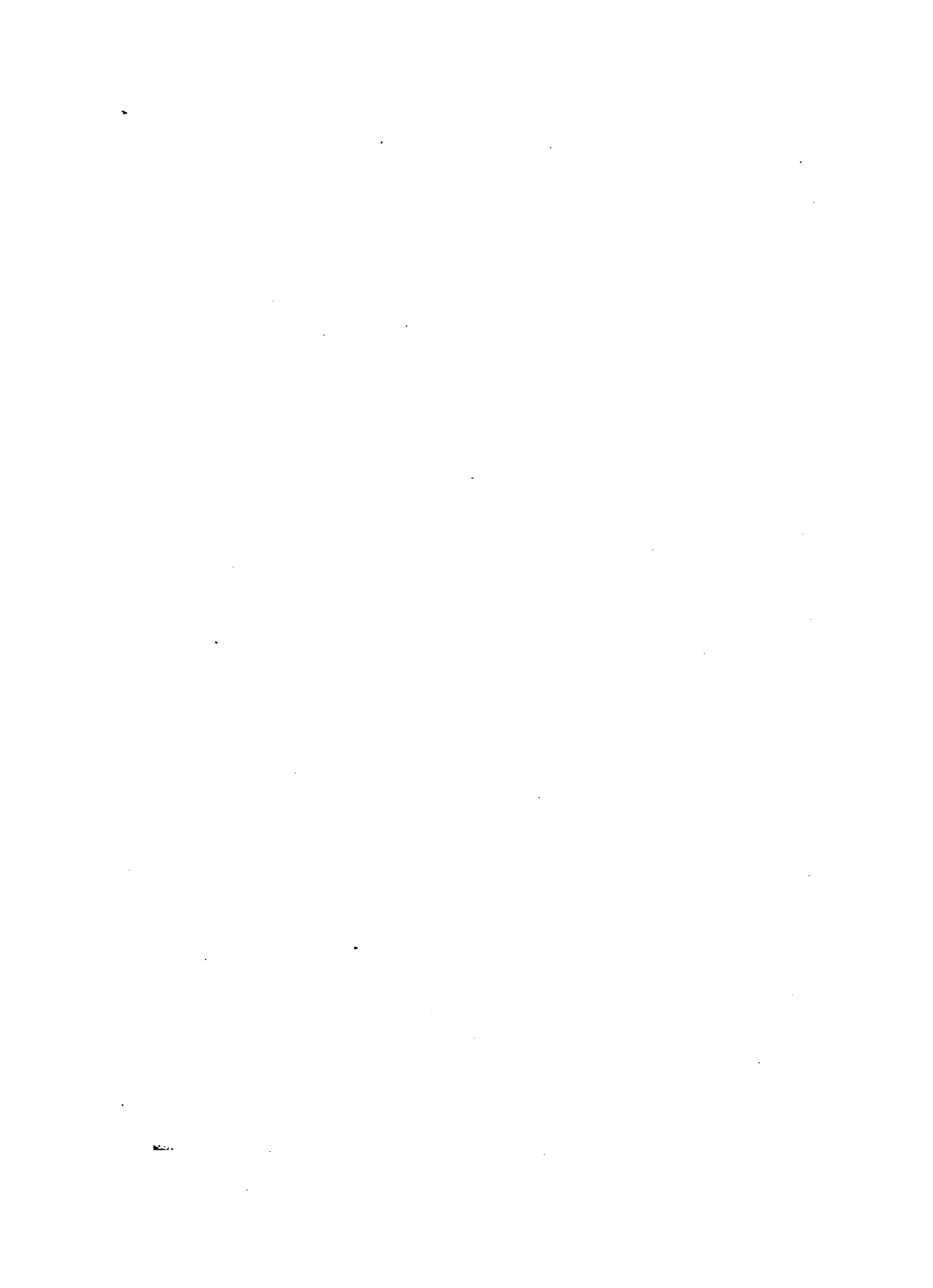
An honest man rare to be found
Lies buried here beneath this ground,
Whose soul we trust is now above
Where all is joy, where all is love.

Here lies interred the body of Mrs. Elizabeth, wife of Capt. Eliphalet Carpenter who departed this life May the 6th, A. D. 1773, in the 68th year of her age. The first buried in this ground.
