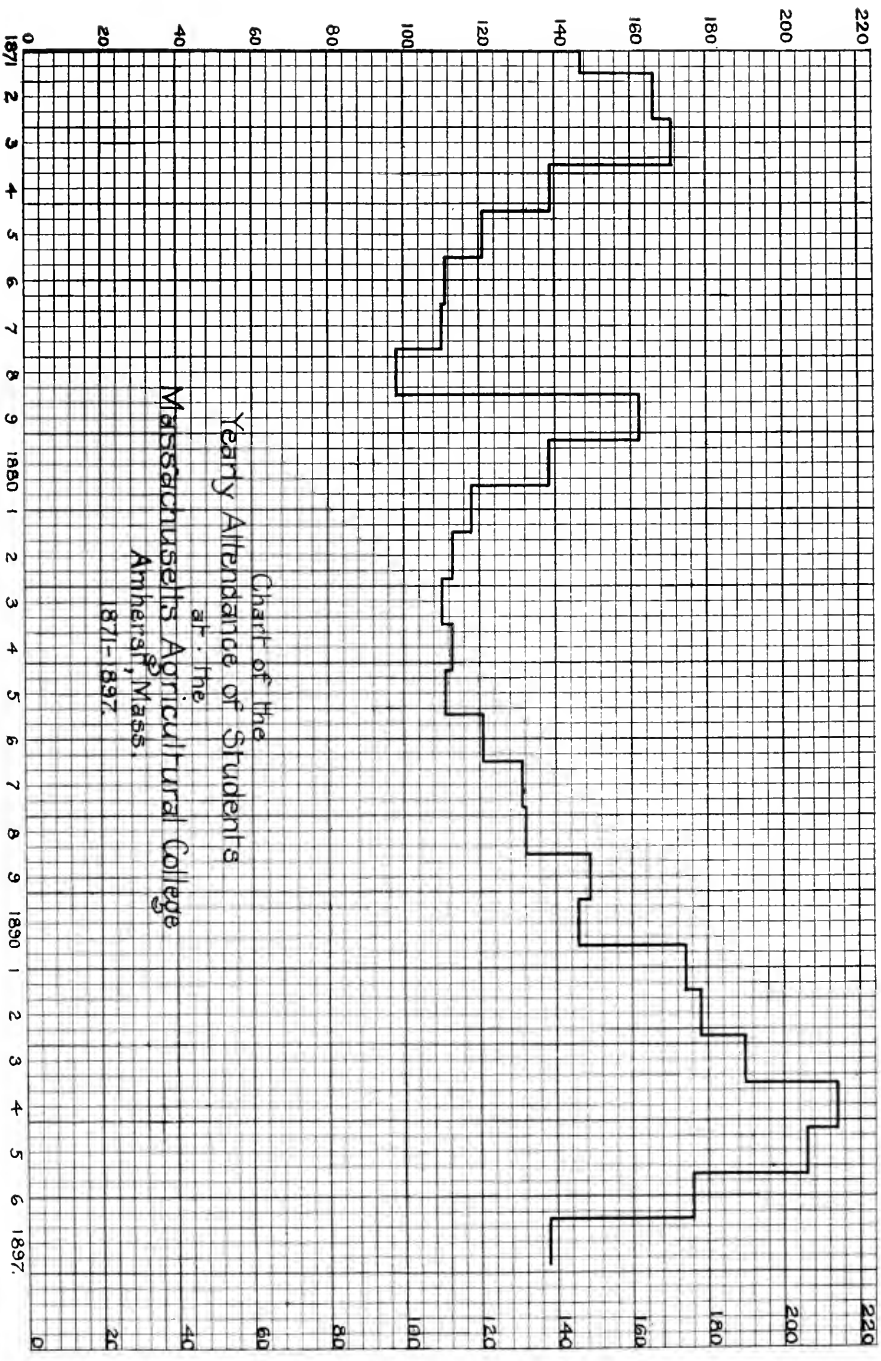


Chart of the
