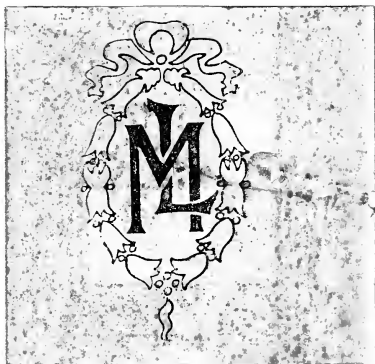

REGULATIONS OF PORTERS,

As fixed by the Magistrates, March 1st, 1798.

By an Act of the Magistrates and Town Council of Glasgow, no Porter shall refuse employment, when he is not otherwise engaged, under the penalty of 2s. 6d. sterling for the first offence, 5s. for the second, and 10s. for every subsequent offence; and all Porters who say they are engaged, shall specify the person by whom, and the hour at which, they are engaged, and they shall not refuse to be employed in the interval, between the time they are required to serve and the hour of their engagement, under the penalties aforesaid. As the Porters who wear badges on their breast, find security for their honesty and fidelity, the Magistrates recommend it to the inhabitants to employ only those Porters in matters of importance. The following is a Table of their Fees:

As fixed by the Magistrates of Glasgow.

For every Cart Load from or to the Broomielaw, the length of the head of Queen-street, along George-street, down Montrose-street, by the Weigh-house, Candleriggs, Bell-street, the Well above the Cross to the Spoutmouth in Gallowgate, and thence westwards

For every Cart Load of Sugar to the Stockwell and Queen-street Sugar Houses, when taken off with a crane

For 2 puncheons of beans or meal, or 2 yarn bales, or any other large cask about 1 ton weight, or a cart load of cork, as much as can be laid on for the same distance as above

For every other place of delivery within the Royalty or New Town, per cart load

For every 10 bolls of oats, beans and wheat, and every 8 bolls of barley, to all the Granaries at the Broomielaw, Jamaica-street, Grahamston, Stockwell and Argyll-street, the Carters always finding sufficient bags, and carrying the whole of their load up one story, or into a ground flat, without any assistance from the employer, per cart

When the cart load is to be carried up more than one story, the employer shall pay the Carter per cart, an additional

But in this last case the Carter may carry up the half of the load at his own expence, the employer being at the expence of the other half.

For every cart load of Grain to any other part of the Royalty or New Town than is above stated

The carriage in this last case to be subject to the above Regulations as to delivery up one story or into a ground flat, or up more than one story.

Carters employed to remove furniture or similar articles, that require long time to load and unload, shall be paid for the first hour they are so employed, and so proportionally for each cart

And for every other hour, and so proportionally, for each cart

The Carter, in such cases shall always assist in loading and unloading, but to remain always by his Cart.

In all cases Carters are to load and unload such articles on their Carts, as they are capable of doing; and in other instances, they shall assist in loading and unloading their Carts.

All such quantities as are to be considered as a single Cart load, and likewise all rates of fares, not before specially provided for, in case of any dispute concerning these between the Carter and his employer shall be settled by the sitting magistrate.

No Carters, or servants of Carters, shall exact higher fares than those before specified, under the penalty of five shillings for each offence, to be levied by a summary warrant from any of the Magistrates of Glasgow, and by imprisonment till payment of the same be made, besides forfeiting the fares overcharged.

Masters and Owners of Vessels arriving at the Broomielaw, Port-Glasgow, or Greenock, who are not previously hired or engaged, and whilst they remain there unengaged, shall be obliged to accept of the first freight that is offered at the rates before specified, under the penalty of 20s. for each offence; and if the Master or Owner of any Vessel, shall ask and demand any higher freights than those before specified; he shall be liable to a like penalty of 20s. sterling for each offence.

After freights at the foresaid rates shall have been agreed for, or offered to Masters or Owners of Vessels, it shall not be lawful to nor in the power of any other Shippers to disappoint the first freighter or offerer, by bargaining with the Master or Owner for a freight at a higher rate, all which second bargains and agreements shall be void and null, and the Master and Owner who makes them, shall be liable in a penalty of 20s. for each offence. When a Shipper or Shippers conjunctly, shall ship the whole Goods conveyed in any vessel, for a trip or voyage, without having Goods belonging to any other persons on board, the Master or Owner shall be entitled to a full freight for the Vessel at the rate aforesaid, although the freight of the Goods might be less than a full freight, if it were seperately calculated at the rates aforesaid, upon the different articles of which the Cargo consisted.

Which report being considered by the Magistrates and Council, they approve thereof, and ratify and confirm the Table of Fees therein contained, and appoint the same to take place from and after the date hereof, and prohibit and discharge the Masters of Vessels and all other persons navigating the River Clyde, from exacting or levying any higher freights, for transporting Goods upon the said River, than those before specified.

The City is divided into twenty-four Wards, or Districts: under the inspection of twenty-four Commissioners, chosen upon the first Monday of September annually: Mr. John Sterhouse, Captain of Police: Donald M'Lean, James Johnston, Sergeants: Andrew Anderson, Hugh M'Intyre, Alexander Stewart, Peter M'Donald, William Barry, Officers, and sixty-three Watchmen.

REGULATIONS.

A Sergeant with three of the above Officers are to attend alternately, at the Police Office, Candleiggs, half an hour before the Watchmen take their Stations, to call the roll of the Watchmen, and mark such as are absent. The Sergeant and Officers are thereafter to patrol the streets until between two and three in the morning, or longer if necessary; to observe if the Watchmen are doing their duty; to apprehend vagrants and disorderly persons; and to give, in writing, a report of the whole transactions, in the morning, to the Master of Police.

The Watchmen are to be on their respective Stations, in the months of April to September inclusive, at 10 o'clock at night, and continue till 4 in the morning; and in the months of October to March inclusive, at 9 o'clock at night, and continue until 6 in the morning; and to sweep the streets twice a-week before 9 in the morning.
