


## **Good Sense**

## by Baron Paul Henri Thiry d'Holbach (1723–1789)

In 1770, Baron D'Holbach published his masterpiece, Système de la Nature, which for a long time passed as the posthumous work of M. de Mirabaud. That text-book of "Atheistical Philosophy" caused a great sensation, and two years later the Baron published this excellent abridgment of it, freed from arbitrary ideas; and by its clearness of

expression, facility, and precision of style, rendered it most suitable for the average student. This text is based on an undated English translation of *Le Bon Sens* published c. 1900. (Summary from editor's preface)
