ORDER

During the evidentiary hearing on April 23, 2015, the Court ordered the MCSO Defendants¹ to immediately disclose certain materials discussed in the Court's colloquy with Sheriff Arpaio. Because of the need for the disclosure to occur on an expedited basis, the documents were not initially Bates stamped for control purposes. Attorney review for privilege was conducted contemporaneously with this production, and dual copies of the documents were made, one of which was provided to the Monitor and the other which was retained by the MCSO Defendants. The MCSO is still in the process of producing some such documents.

The MCSO Defendants shall promptly affix Bates numbers to the documents disclosed to the Monitor and, as soon as is reasonably possible, transmit copies of the
