Arpaio, in his individual and 13 official capacity as Sheriff of Maricopa County, AZ; et al. 14 Defendants. 15 16 The Court held a Status Conference on April 3, 2014 at which it heard testimony 17 from Deputy Chief David Trombi and addressed various other issues related to 18 enforcement and modification of the Supplemental Permanent Injunction/Judgment Order 19 ("Injunction Order") (Doc. 606). The Court ordered Defendants to produce a schedule 20 within seven days of April 3, 2014. That schedule should specify exactly how that 21 training would proceed after approval from the Monitor. The Plaintiffs expressed concern 22 that Defendants should be able to complete their training in a shorter time period. The 23 Court ordered the Plaintiffs to submit any recommended changes within fourteen days of 24 April 3, 2014. 25 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendants shall submit a proposed training 26 schedule within seven days of April 3, 2014.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiffs shall submit any proposed

amendments to Defendants' schedule within fourteen days of April 3, 2014.
