PURSUANT TO Defendant's Motion to Continue Trial, the government having no objection, and good cause shown,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED continuing the trial in the above-entitled case from the 11th day of August, 2009, to the 13th day of October, 2009, at 9:00 a.m.

For the reasons set forth in the Motion, to wit: failure to continue the proceeding would deny counsel for the Defendant the reasonable time necessary for effective preparation, taking into account the exercise of due diligence (18 U.S.C. § 3161(h) (8) (B) (iv)). In light of the above, the Court specifically finds that the ends of justice served by granting a continuance outweigh the best interests of the public and the Defendant in a speedy trial.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED extending the deadline for filing pretrial motions to the 18th day of September, 2009.
