PURSUANT TO Defendant's Motion to Continue Trial, the government having no objection, and good cause shown,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED continuing the trial in the above-entitled case from the 10<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2010, to the 13<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2010, at 9:00 a.m.

For the reasons set forth in the Motion, to wit: failure to continue the proceeding would <sup>deny</sup> the Defendant, proceeding *pro se*, the reasonable time necessary for effective preparation, taking into account the exercise of due diligence (18 U.S.C. § 3161(h) <sup>7</sup>/~~8~~ (B) (iv)).
