Counsel shall appear at the Scheduling Conference and at all pretrial meetings fully informed concerning the facts of the case and shall be the attorney who will be in charge of the trial, unless good cause is shown for the appearance of other counsel or for a telephonic appearance. If there is a first appearance by any party after the date of this Order, counsel for Plaintiff shall give a copy of this Order to that party.
