19 COMES NOW, PLAINTIFF DENNIS MORRIS, ("Plaintiff" or "Morris") and
20 complains of and alleges the following:

21 **INTRODUCTION AND OVERVIEW**

22 1. This is a clear liability copyright infringement case, wherein Defendants,
23 engaged in advertising activity, including but not limiting to, making, without
24 authorization, posters, lithographs, paintings and other art featuring Plaintiff's copyright
25 protected photograph, causing significant advertising injury to Plaintiff. Plaintiff seeks
26 recovery of all remedies available under law including but not limited to its damages,
27 all of Defendants' profits, and payment of Plaintiff's attorneys fees and costs.
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JURISDICTION AND VENUE

2. This Court has federal question jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. §§ 1331, 1338(a).

3. The claims asserted herein arose in this judicial district and all Defendants do business in this judicial district.

4. Venue in this judicial district is proper under 28 U.S.C. § 1391(b) and (c) and 1400(a) in that this is the judicial district in which a substantial part of the acts and omissions giving rise to the claims occurred.

5. This is an action for copyright infringement under the Copyright Act of 1976, Title 17 U.S.C. § 101 et seq., seeking damages, attorneys’ fees, preliminary and permanent injunctive relief, an accounting, as well as damages and other relief based upon other claims related to the misappropriation of Plaintiff’s intellectual property.

PARTIES

6. Plaintiff DENNIS MORRIS, an individual, is a photographer and artist, who has gained worldwide recognition for his original and groundbreaking photographs, including photographs of musical visionaries

7. Plaintiff is informed and believes and thereon alleges that RUSSELL YOUNG, an individual, is a graphic artist and a citizen of the County of Los Angeles, State of California.

8. Plaintiff is informed and believes and thereon alleges that DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, created, assembled, distributed, manufactured and/or sold artwork bearing Plaintiff’s copyrighted SUBJECT IMAGE (as hereinafter defined). The true names and capacities, whether corporate, individual or otherwise, of the Defendant DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, are unknown to Plaintiff who therefore sues said Defendants by such fictitious names, and will ask leave to amend this Complaint to show their true names and capacities when the same have been ascertained. As used hereafter the term Defendants shall mean and refer to RUSSELL YOUNG and DOES 1 through 10.

1 9. Plaintiff is informed and believes and thereon alleges that at all times
2 relevant hereto, each of the Defendants, including without limitation the DOE
3 Defendants, was the agent, affiliate, officer, director, manager, principal, partner, joint
4 venturer, alter-ego and/or employee of the remaining Defendants and was at all times
5 acting within the scope of such agency, affiliate, officer, director, manager, principal,
6 partner, joint venturer, alter-ego and/or employment relationship and actively
7 participated in, or subsequently ratified and adopted, or both, each and all of the acts or
8 conduct alleged herein, with full knowledge of all the facts and circumstances,
9 including, but not limited to, full knowledge of each and all of the violations of
10 Plaintiff's rights and the damages to Plaintiff proximately caused thereby.

11 **CLAIM FOR RELIEF**

12 **COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT UNDER 17 U.S.C. § 101 ET SEQ.**

13 (Against All Defendants and Each of Them)

14 11. Plaintiff repeats, realleges and incorporates by reference in this paragraph
15 the allegations contained in this Complaint as if fully set forth herein.

16 12. Plaintiff took the following original photograph of the musician Sid
17 Vicious, (hereinafter "Subject Image"), which contains materials wholly original with
18 Plaintiff and is copyrightable subject matter under the laws of the United States.

1 13. The Subject Image was published by Plaintiff in his book, entitled Destroy:
2 The Sex Pistols 1977 (2002, Creation Books), ISBN-10: 184068058X; ISBN-13: 978-
3 1840680584, for which Plaintiff applied for and received a copyright registration VA 1-
4 785-966.

5 14. Plaintiff is informed and believes and thereon alleges that Defendants
6 including all DOE Defendants, their customers and suppliers and each of them, had
7 access to the Subject Image, including without limitation, access through Plaintiff's
8 book, access through copies published on the internet and access through illegal copies.

9 15. Defendants wrongfully created copies of the copyrighted Subject Image
10 without Plaintiff's consent and engaged in acts of affirmative and widespread self-
11 promotion of the copies directed to the public at large by distributing said copies (and
12 accompanying written materials) with a false and misleading designation of creation,
13 ownership and origin, and falsely representing that the Subject Image was their own.

14 16. Plaintiff is informed and believes and thereon alleges that Defendants, and
15 each of them, further infringed Plaintiff's copyright by making derivative works from
16 Plaintiff's copyrighted Subject Image, and/or by producing and distributing garments
17 incorporating those derivative works without Plaintiff's permission. Defendants then
18 engaged in acts of affirmative and widespread self-promotion of the copies directed to
19 the public at large by publicly claiming ownership rights in and to the derivative works
20 based on the Subject Image that belong solely to Plaintiff.

1 23. Defendants' acts of copyright infringement and acts of affirmative and
2 widespread self-promotion of the copies directed to the public at large, as alleged
3 above, have caused Plaintiff to suffer, and to continue to suffer, substantial damage to
4 its business in the form of diversion of trade, loss of income and profits, and a dilution
5 of the value of its rights.

6 24. Further, as a direct result of the acts of copyright infringement and acts of
7 affirmative and widespread self-promotion of the copies directed to the public at large
8 alleged above, Defendants, and each of them, have obtained direct and indirect profits
9 they would not otherwise have realized but for their infringement of Plaintiff's
10 copyrighted Subject Image. Plaintiff is entitled to disgorgement of each Defendant's
11 profits directly and indirectly attributable to said Defendant's infringement of the
12 Subject Image.

14 **PRAYER FOR RELIEF**

15 WHEREFORE, Plaintiff prays for judgment as follows:

- 16 1. That Defendants, and each of them, and their respective agents and servants
17 be enjoined from infringing Plaintiff's copyright in any manner;
- 18 2. That Plaintiff be awarded all profits of Defendants, and each of them, plus all
19 losses of Plaintiff, the exact sum to be proven at the time of trial, or, if elected before
20 final judgment, statutory damages, as available under the Copyright Act, 17 U.S.C. §
21 101 et seq.;
- 22 3. That Plaintiff be awarded its attorneys' fees as available under the Copyright
23 Act, 17 U.S.C. § 101 et seq.;
- 24 4. That Defendants, and each of them, account to Plaintiff for their profits and
25 any damages sustained by Plaintiff arising from the foregoing acts of infringement;
- 26 5. That Plaintiff be awarded pre-judgment interest as allowed by law;
- 27 6. That Plaintiff be awarded the costs of this action; and




