23	The United States moves ex parte pursuant to Criminal Local Rule 47-3 to continue the status		
24	conference in the above-captioned action from July 25, 2013, to August 8, 2013, at 2:00 pm. The		
25	United States has communicated with counsel for the Pangang Group defendants and counsel concurs		
26	that proceeding by <i>ex parte</i> motion is appropriate.		
27	The reasons for this motion are as follows:		
28	1. The Court has granted defendants' motion to quash and held that the United States has not		
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effectively served summonses on defendants pursuant to Fed. R. Crim. P. 4. The Court scheduled a
 status conference so that the government could advise the Court and defendants how it intends to
 proceed with the pending prosecution of the Pangang Group defendants

2. The United States Department of Justice has been considering the available options. The
 Department of Justice has not reached a final determination as to the most appropriate way to proceed,
 though a decision will be made shortly.

3. The defendants in this case who are before the Court – Walter Liew, Christina Liew, Robert
Maegerle, and USAPTI – are scheduled to appear on August 8, 2013, for a hearing on motions and
various other matters.

4. The government anticipates that will be in a position to advise the Court on August 8, 2013, how
it wishes to proceed with the prosecution of the Pangang Group defendants.

12 5. Counsel for the United States has notified counsel for the Pangang Group defendants that the
13 United States will request a continuance from July 25, 2013, to August 8, 2013. Counsel for the
14 Pangang Group defendants advised that the government should represent to the Court that his client has
15 no position regarding the date of the status conference.

6. Given that Pangang Group defendants' are appearing specially through counsel and their
counsel's representation that defendants have no position regarding the date of the status hearing,
proceeding by *ex parte* motion is appropriate.

For these reasons, the United States respectfully requests that the Court continue the status
hearing regarding the Pangang Group defendants from July 25, 2013, to August 8, 2013.
