

Agnolucci in Support of the Defendants' Joint Motion for a Bill of 17 Particulars be maintained under seal until further order, because the United States required more 18 time to make a showing that the items were sealable. (See Docket Nos. 318, 320.) In that Order, the Court directed the parties to meet and confer about modifying the 19 20 Protective Order in this case to address the procedures for filing documents under seal. The 21 Court directed that the parties should strive to have those procedures conform as closely as 22 possible to Criminal Local Rules 55-1(b) and Civil Local Rule 79-5. The Court further directed 23 that if the parties could not reach an agreement, they should present any disputes to Magistrate 24 Judge Cousins in the first instance.

There has been no further action on this motion to seal, since the Court issued the Order
directing the parties to meet and confer. Thus, the Court has not yet made a final ruling on the
motion to seal.
