1	KECTI ALS	
2	A. On September 18, 2012, a case management conference in the above-captioned	
3	action was set for January 11, 2013 (ECF No. 28).	
4	B. On September 26, 2012, the Court entered an order on the parties' stipulation	
5	that consolidated these actions and deferred Defendants' obligation to respond to any	
6	complaints until after the Court appoints a lead plaintiff and lead counsel for this consolidated	
7	securities class action. (ECF No. 30). The Court ordered Defendants to meet and confer with	
8	court-appointed lead counsel within fourteen days after the Court makes its appointment to	
9	discuss a schedule for filing a consolidated amended complaint and Defendants' response. (Id.)	
10	C. On February 15, 2013, the Court is scheduled to hear argument on the competing	
11	motions for appointment of lead plaintiff and lead counsel. (ECF No. 104.)	
12	D. The parties agree that any obligations to meet and confer should be deferred until	
13	after the Court issues an order on the competing motions for appointment of lead plaintiff and	
14	lead counsel. Until the Court issues a ruling on those competing motions, there cannot be any	
15	meaningful discussion about the next steps for this litigation.	
16	THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED among the undersigned	
17	parties, subject to Court approval, as follows:	
18	(1) The Case Management Conference currently scheduled for January 11, 2013, shall be	
19	continued until further order of the Court.	
20	(2) Counsel for Defendants shall meet and confer with the court-appointed lead counsel	
21	for the lead plaintiff within fourteen days after the Court makes its appointment to discuss a new	
22	case management conference date and submit a proposal with the parties' proposed schedule for
