24	2012. All actions allege that Zynga misrepresented or failed to disclose material facts about its
25	business in public statements that were made before the July 25 announcement. Each plaintiff
26	seeks to represent a class of investors who purchased Zynga stock before the July 25
27	announcement.

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1	All of the actions allege violations of	the federal securities laws. All of the complaints

4	the Securities Act of 1933. These actions in	volve substantially overlapping events, parties, and
