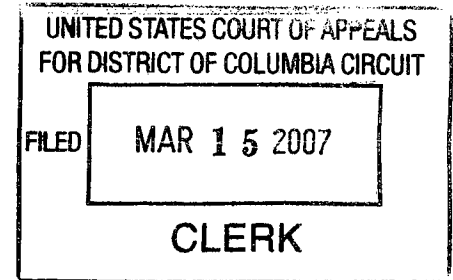

ORDER
