## ORDER

1. Upon a representation by the United States that the defendant has never been subject of "routine processing" (booking, fingerprinting, photographing) in this case:

2. It is the 4TH day of APRIL 2008 ORDERED:

3. That if the defendant is released on bond that he or she be accompanied on **to be determined** by Department of Labor Investigator Kenric Michel to the Central Cell Block of the Metropolitan Police Department, to the United States Marshal's Office and to the First District Police Station MPD for "routine processing," and that this be a condition of being released on bond;

4. That if the defendant is not released on bond, the United States Marshall shall release the defendant to the custody of Investigator Michel for the purpose of "routine processing," and at the conclusion thereof to return the defendant to the custody of the Marshal.
