UNITED STATES APPLICATION TO DISCLOSE CERTAIN TAX INFORMATION

COMES NOW the United States of America, by and through undersigned counsel, and moves this Honorable Court for an order allowing the government to disclose certain records obtained from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS). On November 21, 2006, the court issued an Order, Misc. Case No. 06-00033, directing the IRS to disclose to the U.S. Attorney's Office any information it held on Taxpayer Identification Number XXX-XX-7064, among others.

Defendant Lee was indicted in the above-entitled matter on February 20, 2009, and made her initial appearance February 26, 2008. She is represented by Howard Trapp. The government seeks permission to release the IRS data concerning the TINs which were the subject of this order, so that Mr. Trapp can evaluate the strength of the government's case. The release of such
