## MOTION FOR TOTAL WAIVER OF FILING FEES UNDER THE TWENTY FOURTH AMENDMENT; VOTING

Petitioner, Keith Russell Judd, Pro Se, hereby moves this Court for a total waiver of filing fees and costs pursuant to the Twenty Fourth Amendment proving the right of citizens to Vote in Federal Elections "shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or any State by reason of failure to pay any poll tax or other tax. This type of Voting Rights action is exempt from the Prison Litigation Reform Act, 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g), et seq., as it hasnothing to do with prison spinditions.
