I. INTRODUCTION

The plaintiff, James M. Atkinson ("Atkinson"), has filed a 474-page *pro se* complaint naming well over 100 defendants, including John Good ("Good"), who is being sued in his official capacity and individually in connection with his affiliation with various institutional defendants. This matter is presently before the court on his Motion to Dismiss (Docket No. 44), pursuant to which Good is seeking to have the Third Amended Complaint ("Compl.")¹ dismissed as against him for failure to comply with the pleading requirements of Fed. R. Civ. P. 8.² "While a court may dismiss a pleading that
