For the reasons stated in the accompanying Opinion, it is, this 4<sup>th</sup> day of April 2012 ORDERED

- All Doe defendants are SEVERED from this action, except Doe #37 (the first Doe
  defendant listed in Exhibit A to the complaint that has not been voluntarily dismissed
  from the action).
- Plaintiffs' claims against severed Doe defendants 38–848 are DISMISSED without prejudice.
- All subpoenas seeking severed defendants' personal identifying information are hereby QUASHED.
- Plaintiff SHALL IMMEDIATELY NOTIFY subpoena recipients that the subpoenas have been quashed and that Doe defendants, except Doe #37, have been severed and are not litigants in this case.
- 5. ISPs shall file, under seal, copies of all notices sent to Doe defendants pursuant to paragraph 4 above.

- 6. Moving forward, all documents filed in this action that contain Doe #37's identifying information shall be filed under seal.
- 7. All pending motions from severed defendants are DENIED as moot.
