<u>ORDER</u>

This matter is before the court on the parties' failure to file a proposed stipulated discovery plan and scheduling order. The Complaint (#1) in this matter was filed October 18, 2011. Defendants filed Motions to Dismiss (Dkt. ##9, 10) February 3, 2012. Pursuant to LR 26-1, the parties were required to meet and/or confer as required by Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(f) within 30 days after the first defendant answered or otherwise appeared, and 14 days thereafter to file a mandatory stipulated discovery plan and scheduling order. To date, the parties have not complied. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. The following discovery plan and scheduling order dates shall apply:

a. The parties shall meet and/or confer as required by Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(f) not later than 4:00 p.m., April 9, 2012.

b. Last date to complete discovery: **August 1, 2012.**

c. Last date to amend pleadings and add parties: May 3, 2012.

d. Last date to file interim status report: June 4, 2012.

e. Last date to disclose experts pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(a)(2): June 4, 2012.

f. Last date to disclose rebuttal experts: July 2, 2012.

g. Last date to file dispositive motions: August 31, 2012.

- h. Last date to file joint pretrial order: October 1. 2012. In the event dispositive motions are filed, the date for filing the joint pretrial order shall be suspended until 30 days after a decision of the dispositive motions.
- 2. The disclosures required by Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(a)(3), and any objections thereto, shall be included in the pretrial order.
- 3. Applications to extend any dates set by this discovery plan and scheduling order shall, in addition to satisfying the requirements of LR 6-1, be supported by a showing of good cause for the extension. All motions or stipulations to extend discovery shall be received no later than **4:00 p.m., July 11, 2012,** and shall fully comply with the requirements of LR 26-4.
