ANN DONNELLY, District Judge.

WHEREAS MARYAM MIKANIKI is a member of the petitioning class; and

WHEREAS Ms. Mikaniki will land at John F. Kennedy International Airport (“JFK
Airport”) at approximately 6:35 pm on January 29, 2017; and

WHEREAS on January 28, 2017, this Court issued a stay of the January 27, 2017
executive order, which, among other things, enjoined removal of immigrants from █████ who have
valid immigrant visas;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Ms. Mikaniki, being a member of the class of
petitioners in this proceeding, pursuant to the orders entered in *Hameed Khalid Darweesh and
Haider Sameer Abdulkhaleq Alshawi v. Donald Trump, et. al*, No. 17 Civ. 480 (AMD)
(E.D.N.Y.) (January 29, 2017) and *Mazdak Pourabdollah Tootkaboni and Arghavan*

Louhghalam, v. Donald Trump, CV No. 17-cv-10154 (January 29, 2017) (D. Mass), may not be detained or removed pursuant to the January 27 executive order.
