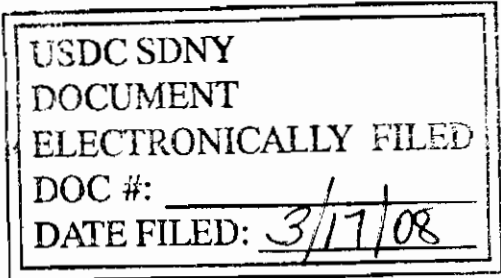


**ORDER**
