Plaintiff is entitled to 28 29 judgment as a matter of law on all claims articulated in the First Amended Complaint. 30

1	NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:
2	Defendants, their officers, agents, servants, employees,
3	and all persons in active concert or participation with them who
4	receive actual notice, are permanently enjoined from enforcing
5	Rule/Policy Number P 060-8.14.
6	Rule/Policy Number P 060-8.14 violates the U.S. and
7	Washington constitutions, and is thus null and void.
8	Plaintiff is awarded nominal damages in the amount of
9	one dollar.
10	Plaintiff is awarded costs of suit.
11	Plaintiff is awarded punitive damages against Defendant
12	Nickels in his individual capacity in the amount of
13	, an amount determined by the Court to
14	be sufficient to effectively deter future Washington municipal
15	officials from behaving with reckless or callous disregard for
16	federally protected rights.
