



FOREWORD







FIRST FLOOR PLAN, FROEBEL SCHOOL






BASEMENT PLAN, FROEBEL SCHOOL







FLOOR PLANS, GRAEME STEWART SCHOOL, CHICAGO, ILL.






SECOND FLOOR PLAN, PUBLIC SCHOOL, MADISONVILLE, O.












FLOOR PLAN, PUBLIC SCHOOL NO. 20, ROCHESTER, N. Y. J. Foster Warner, Architect, Rochester















FLOOR PLANS, CASTELLAR SCHOOL, OMAHA, NEB. John Latenser, Architect, Omaha




BASEMENT PLAN, SHURTLEFF SCHOOL, CHELSEA, MASS.













THIRD FLOOR PLAN, WILLIAMS SCHOOL, CHELSEA, MASS.




SECOND FLOOR PLAN, WILLIAMS SCHOOL, CHELSEA, MASS.







FIRST FLOOR PLAN, WILLIAMS SCHOOL, CHELSEA, MASS.


THIRD FLOOR PLAN, PUBLIC SCHOOL NO. 1, TROY, N. Y.







GROUND FLOOR PLAN, PUBLIC SCHOOL NO. 1, TROY, N. Y.


















FLOOR PLANS, FIELD SCHOOL, ST. LOUIS, MO.









FIRST FLOOR PLAN, AVONDALE SCHOOL, CINCINNATI, O.




BASEMENT PLAN, AVONDALE SCHOOL, CINCINNATI, O.








SECOND FLOOR PLAN, OAK HILL SCHOOL, ST. LOUIS.




FIRST FLOOR PLAN, OAK HILL SCHOOL, ST. LOUIS.




BASEMENT PLAN, OAK HILL SCHOOL, ST. LOUIS.









SECOND FLOOR PLAN. GEO. W. CLAYTON SCHOOL, DENVER, COLO.




BASEMENT PLAN, PROSPECT POINT SCHOOL.




