



Dedication

B. Todd Troost, M.D.

Dr. Troost was raised in Mankato, MN, and graduated *magna cum laude* from Shattuck Military Academy in 1955. He received a B.S. degree in biophysics with honors from Yale University in 1959, and then he earned his M.D. degree from Harvard University in 1963. He completed internship at the University of Colorado Medical Center and subsequently became a U.S. Army flight surgeon where he served thirteen months in Korea. He then returned to residency in Neurology and completed training in 1969. The next two years were spent as an NIH-sponsored fellow in neuro-ophthalmology and then in a fellowship in the Ocular Motor Laboratory at the University of Miami.

In 1980, Dr. Troost served as Vice-Chairman of the Neurology Department at Case Western Reserve University where he also completed a Master's degree in computer science. Then in 1983, he became the Chairman of the Department of Neurology at Bowman Gray School of Medicine. He received the "Golden Apple" Award for clinical teaching in 1985, 1986, 1987, and 1988. He has authored over 200 neurological papers and is the webmaster for five major neurologic websites.

In addition to being a well-trained physician and an astute clinician, Dr. Troost is incredibly generous with his time to medical education. He serves regularly as neurology attending physician, actively participates in second and third year neurology lectures, and maintains a website filled with information for students. He takes personal time with each third-year rotation group, freely offers career planning advice and reads more *curricula vitarum* and personal statements than any one person should.

Dr. Troost's kindness and generosity have not gone unnoticed, so with gratitude and admiration, this 2000 *Gray Matter* is proudly dedicated to Dr. Todd Troost.

Alexis will be dearly missed by both family and friends but her memory will remain as a reminder of her beautiful life.




Wake Forest University

Ninety-eight years ago, Wake Forest College Medical School opened its doors to a roster of 13 students in Wake County, North Carolina. The year was 1902 and students completed a two-year education curriculum before graduation. The medical school at first grew slowly,




School of Medicine: 1902-2000

both in size and in recognition. During these fledgling years, North Carolina Baptist Hospital was also being formed but as a separate entity. Funding for this establishment came from the North Carolina Baptist State Convention and its hospital doors were first opened for patient care in 1923. For the next decade and a half, these two institutions existed separately. Then in 1939,



the will of Bowman Gray, CEO of R. J. Reynolds Tobacco Company, provided for the establishment of a medical school in Winston-Salem. In 1941, the Medical Center was established when Wake Forest College Medical School moved from Wake County to its present site. At this time, the academic curriculum was advanced to a four-year medical program. The school was renamed




Bowman Gray School of Medicine in memory of its benefactor and it then became the 69th academic medical center in the nation. Fifteen years later, Wake Forest College was also moved from its site near the state capital of Raleigh, North Carolina, to its current site in Winston-Salem. The main campus is now located on part of the former estate of the benefactor R. J.



Reynolds. Both growth and prosperity have been present throughout the history of this medical institution. The last decade has been no different seeing two major building surges. In 1991, a \$200 million building project was completed only to be followed by another \$200 million project just the next year. This last project was the force behind completion of the Nursing Center at



the J. Paul Sticht Center on Aging and Rehabilitation, and CompRehab Plaza. Then in 1997, the medical school was once again renamed and is now currently known as Wake Forest University School of Medicine at the Bowman Gray Campus. Today, Wake Forest University Baptist Medical Center is an 831 bed hospital containing state-of-the-art surgical




suites, intensive care units, and its own Brenner Children's Hospital. Greater than 29,000 patients visit the facility annually. In addition, approximately 2,400 students are trained every year including medical students, nursing and nurse anesthesia students, biomedical graduate students, house officers, physician assistant students and allied health students. The



core mission of this institution states a firm committment to providing both superior education for students and teachers of medicine and related fields, in addition to rendering exemplary and efficient patient care. With almost 100 years of history upon which to rely, look for this tradition to continue into the year 2000 and beyond.

Awarded by the academic faculty, medical school administration, and student body




Robert L. Bowden, Jr., B.S.






First-year Orientation Week






Primary Care Day/ Residency Fair

NOVEMBER 6, 1999



XP Summit

OCTOBER 15-16, 1999

Through the case-based curriculum, the Class of 2002 learned of Katie Mahar and her disease, Xeroderma Pigmentosum (XP). This rare genetic disorder is first apparent in early childhood, causing a person to be up to 2000 times more susceptible to ultraviolet radiation damage than the average person. Those affected battle multiple skin cancers and usually survive only into the twenties. Despite its debilitating nature, it is one of the lesser-known diseases. So, the funding for research into the cure of Xeroderma Pigmentosum is lacking.

Spurred into action by the need for research funding, several members of the Class of 2002 organized the XP Summit. This event began in September with medical students educating Forsyth County 10th graders about sun damage and related diseases. The Summit's major events, however, occurred in October and included an academic continuing medical education conference on XP, an XP-Moonlight Run, a post-race celebration, and a benefit concert. Over \$5,000 was raised for Xeroderma Pigmentosum research at this exciting inaugural event!





Tokai Exchange

Since the establishment of the Tokai Exchange program in 1990, students from Wake Forest University School of Medicine and Tokai University located in Isehara, Japan, have been given the opportunity to experience medical training in another country. Traditionally, Tokai students spend six months training at Baptist Hospital while Wake Forest students study for two months abroad. This academic year, Wake Forest University School of Medicine welcomed three students: Saeko Nashimoto, Yuriko Muraki, and Toshiya Yamaguchi. In addition, Michael Land, Class of 2002 traveled to Tokai in the summer of 1999. This year, the exchange helped to foster not only better understanding of medical training around the world but also friendships around the world.

Parent's Weekend


APRIL 9-10, 1999
