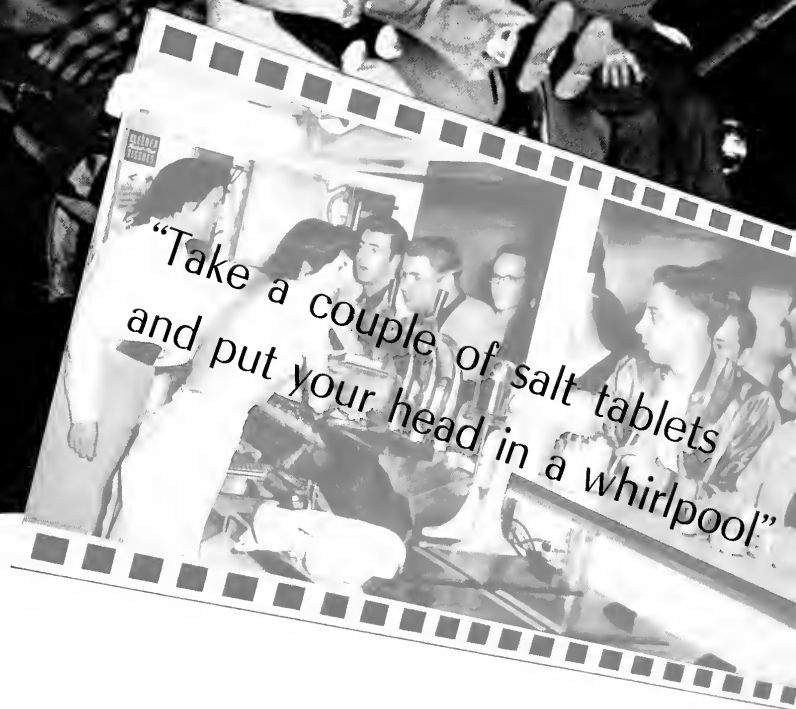

In a special degree I have felt that I belong to the Class of 1953. We were freshmen together in the fall of 1949, my first year in office, yet I am not graduating with you.

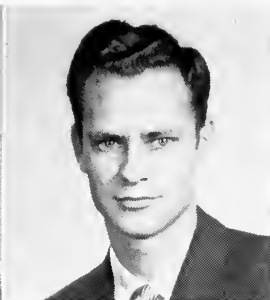

Guilford arrived at College Field for the Bears' last home game, only to feel the might and power of the Bruin eleven, 76 to 0.

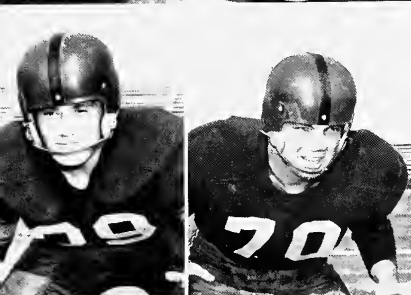
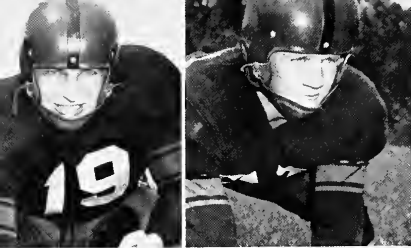

Thanksgiving Day saw the Bears soar to their greatest triumph of the season as they scalped the Catawba tribe 41 to 13 and to cop their second straight North State Championship.

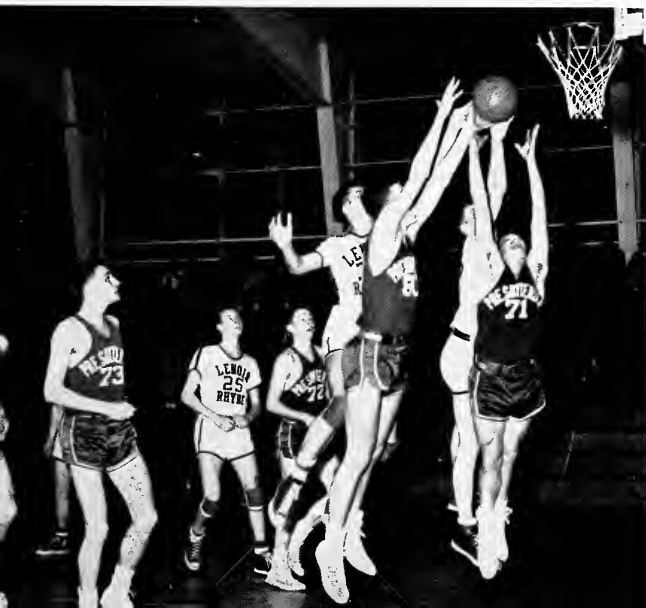

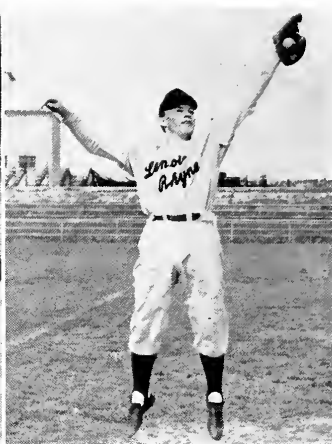

The Bears proved that the pre-season crystal viewers would not be called big fakes and came through to sweep the Western Division Crown and to go on and take the North State Championship.



In conference play of the Western Division of the North State loop the Bruins turned back such teams as Appalachian, Catawba, and Western Carolina. The Mountaineers were the first to venture into the Bruin den only to go limping back to Boone on the short side of a 11-3 score. Catawba, who is always a thorn in the side of the Bruins, came to College Field only to see 6 runs register on the score board while the Indians only had 1. The Catamounts of Western Carolina well remember the Bruins as they felt and saw the power and might of the Bear's bats, 17 to 4. Appalachian

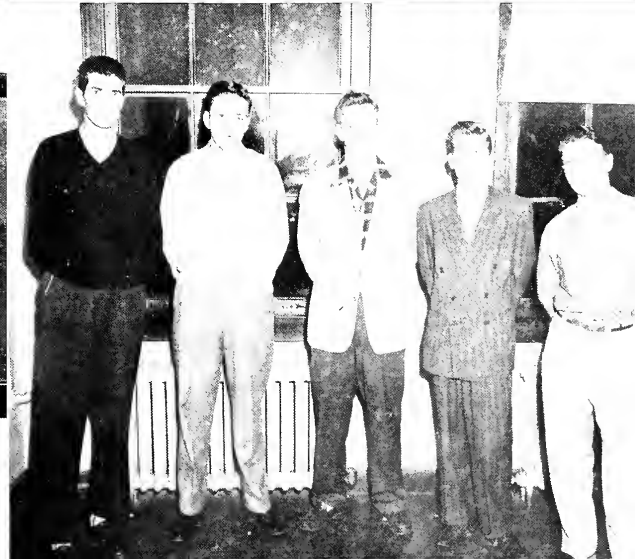
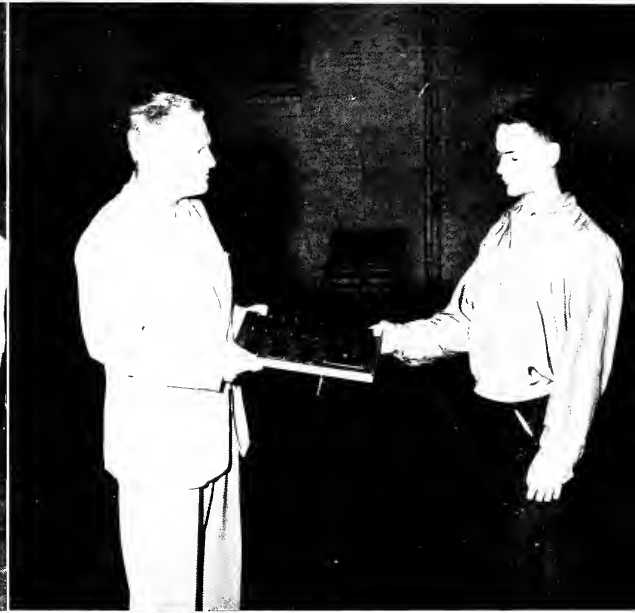
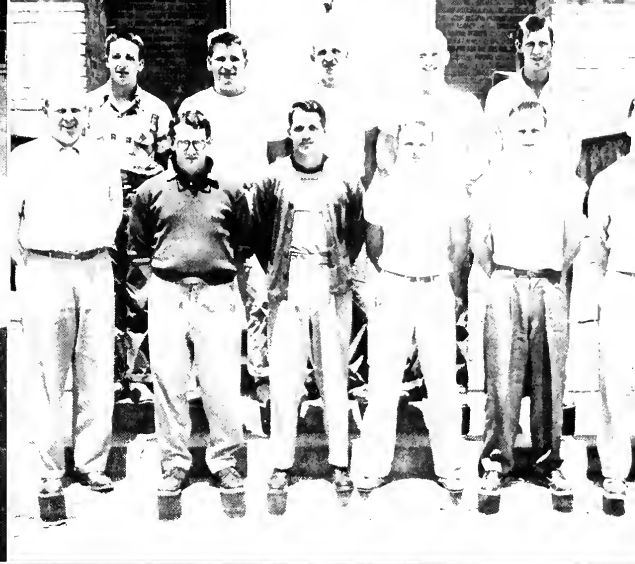




INTRAMURALS

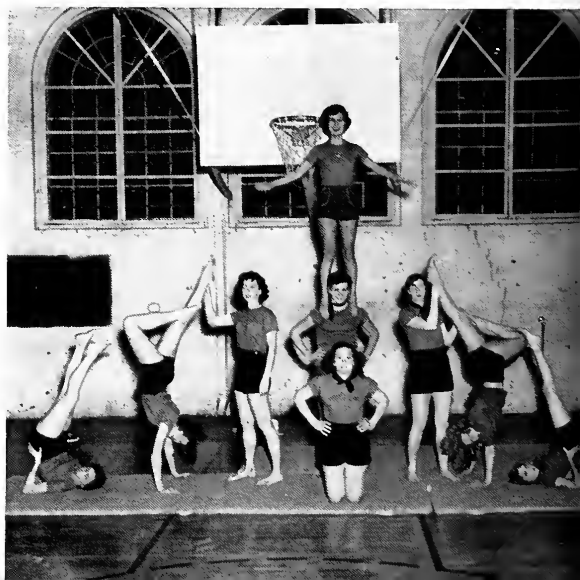

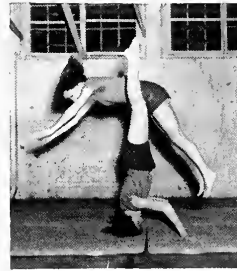

Among the sports played, basketball is a favorite. During the season, competition is aroused between freshman, sophomore, junior, and senior teams, thus providing fun and activity for all.

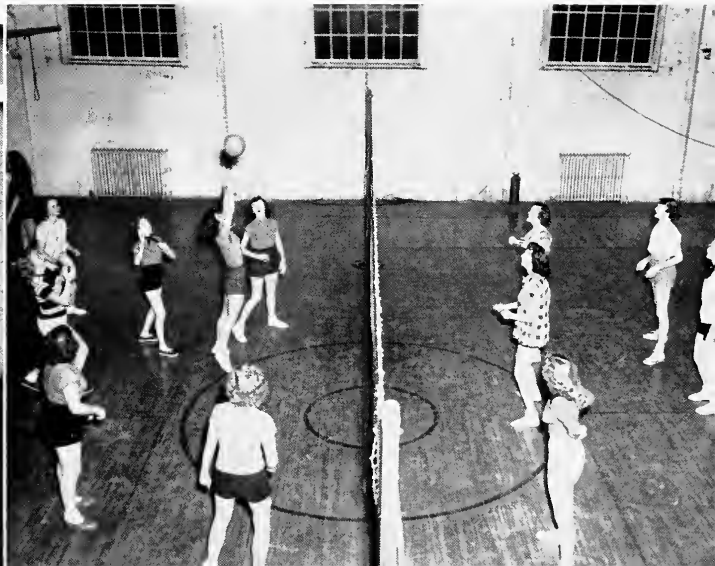
