INTRODUCTION TO THE 1985 EDITION OF THE MILOSLAW JAFFES' PEDIGREE

I can report some progress in my research work over the last two years, apart from the routine recording of births, deaths, marriages and divorces - the latter at an alarming rate!

1) I traced the descendante of three more ancestors up to the present day. The result are eleven new pages: an improved page 5 and its dependent new pages 5a, 5b, 5c, and an improved page 20 with six new dependent pages 20a, 20b, 20bI, 20bII, 20bIII, 20c.

2) By obtaining some information from the partly preserved records of the administration of the Jewish cemeteries in East Berlin, I was able to add, in about thirty cases, the missing dates of death and the grave numbers for some of those Jaffe or née Jaffe ancestors who died in Berlin before World War II and are buried there. This has helped me to confirm the identity of ancestors (single or married) who, so far, had been only names on paper. Here the main difficulty lies in identifying those Jaffes who had the same first name, such as Louis, Herrmann, Adolph etc. Though I have a few dates available, I dare not enter them for fear of errors. So as to save the cemetery administration in East Berlin trouble, I have not asked them for the grave numbers of those ancestors buried there whose exact dates are known to me.

I altered page 1, according to my latest research and compiled a new page 48 after receiving more accurate information from that branch. Also a new page 80 and a new page 96.

I think it is fair to say that the first fifty sheets of the 1985 edition with their numerous additions and corrections show a definite improvement compared with my 1983 version.

For the benefit of deecendants who are not yet acquainted with my work I enclose one or two introductions to previous Jaffe family tree which explain in detail my method of presentation and other points of interest.

My 1985 edition of the Miloslaw Jaffes' pedigree comprises 119 sheets, not counting the introductions and 1 sheet with photographs of early ancestors. Last entry: on 30 Oct. 1985 the birth of a girl on page 78. Please do not forget to enter date and place of my death on page 28 when the time comes. Thank you.

Introduction to its 1983 Version.

- 1) In this latest edition of the Miloslaw Jaffes' pedigree I have combined the information, given in my 1973 and 1976 versions, by adding, wherever possible, the emigration route and the profession of the descendants. I have done this solely for practical reasons, not because I consider the 1973 version invalid.
- 2) The 1983 version (altogether 110 pages) has 25 new pages, 15 of which record newly discovered ancestors and the last 10 pages couples who had their first child between 1976 and 1983. As the research went on, I had to rewrite a number of existing pages, such as p.1, p.2, p.7, p.18 and p.19. You will see how I have overcome the difficulty of incorporating whole new families into the existing pedigree. I may be forgiven for abandoning my usual method of presentation, so as to avoid changing all the page numbers. Finding Samuel Jaffé's 11 children and their descendants on pages 18-18i has been a real struggle, testing even my perseverance. Lack of interest and co-operation - with a few exceptions - are to blame. After one or two disappointments, I have not attempted to approach those descendants who managed to remain in Germany under Nazi regime. As a result, some of these new pages still show gaps.
- 3) However, my patience has been rewarded through the unexpected discovery of a document I had never seen before. In the autumn of 1982, I learnt that our patriarch, Jacob Jehuda ben Chajim's Last Will is in the possession of one of Samuel Jaffé's most helpful descendants, living in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. It was originally written in Hebrew, but Jacob Jehuda's great-grandson Samuel Jaffé had it transcribed into German. The signature on the German copy reads: "15 Tamus 5573/18 July 1813 Jacob Jehuda, son of Ch.", the place was undoubtedly Miloslaw. So Jacob Jehuda ben Chajim Zebi, also known as Lewin Hirsch Jaffe, must have adopted the surname Jaffe between 1813 and his death on 23 June 1822. His Last Will confirms the names and order of birth of his five sons and one daughter and also my uncle Sally Jaffé's conviction that Bune and Esther were not his daughters at all. I have rewritten p.1 of the pedigree accordingly, but am still in the dark about exact dates, because Jacob Jehuda enumerates his children without giving dates.
- 4) The same kind descendant in Rio de Janeiro also sent me Samuel Jaffé's Last Will (50 pages), signed by him in Posen on 26 Febr. 1879, in which he names his 11 children, without dates. It put an end to my ordeal of identifying them from a blurred photograph of a Marcuse family tree, sent to me by Aniela Jaffé (see p.18f) in March 1982.
- 5) From another very helpful Samuel Jaffé descendant I obtained the death certificates for Schiee Jaffe (see p.8) and for Emilie Jaffé, née Marcuse (see p.8 and 18).
- 6) I am, of course, anxious to fill in more gaps on the Miloslaw Jaffes pedigree, and am, at the moment, researching 3 families, with their origin in the Province of Posen, which look promising. But as their descendants, now living in U.S.A., know very little of their past and the gaps occur in the 18th and 19th centuries, I can, so far, neither prove nor disprove their descent from Jacob Jehuda ben Chajim Zebi.

- 7) Since I compiled the 1973 and 1976 versions of my own pedigree, which I call the "Miloslaw Jaffe" family tree, because our early ancestors lived in Miloslaw before moving to the city of Posen, I have compiled the pedigree of another Jaffé family, whose early ancestors moved from Lissa via Schwersenz to Posen. By doing so, I can now answer some of the questions, raised in my introductions to the 1973 and 1976 versions. I am going to summarise my research of the latter family on a separate sheet, as it may be of general interest.
- 8) I am now able to confirm beyond doubt several links through marriage between these two Posen Jaffé families. I have clearly indicated the relationship on the relevant pages of both family trees. I was right in thinking that one Louis Jaffé, belonging to our family, married first one member of the other Posen Jaffé family and, after her death, a first cousin of hers. (See pages 6, 6a and 6b). I have succeeded in tracing the issue of Louis Jaffé's second marriage, but, so far, have been unable to find the 10 children of his first marriage. Two more links I have recorded on p.18h. - The possibility of a more direct relationship between these two Posen Jaffé families cannot be ruled out, though I have been unable to detect it.
- 9) Copies of all my work and documents (wherever possible, the originals) are kept in the archives of the Leo Baeck Institute, 129 East 73rd Street, New York, N.Y. 10021 U.S.A. Please note: dates are given throughout my work in the order, common in Europe, i.e. day, month, year. I realised too late that, on other continents, one puts the month before the day. To avoid misunderstanding, I have written the month in full on all the new or rewritten pages. However, I could not face retyping the whole family tree because of this ambiguity.

Summary of my Research  
on

"One Line of the Rabbi Mordecai Jaffe Pedigree".

On page II, paragraph 7) of my introduction to the 1983 version of the "Miloslaw" Jaffe pedigree, I refer to the family tree of another Posen Jaffé family, originating from Lissa and Schwersenz. As I used "Pedigree III", printed on p.55, Vol.VII of the Jewish Encyclopedia as a starting point for my research, I call my compilation "One Line of the Rabbi Mordecai Jaffe Pedigree", though I am not wholly convinced that this is justified. There is a generation gap of about 120 years between Rabbi Mordecai Jofe (1540-1612), called "Lewush" after his work on rabbinical law, and Elias Meier Jaffe of Lissa whom I make the patriarch of this family, because I have his date of death (1810) documented.

My hope of finding out more about this family's direct descent from Rabbi Mordecai by tracing a complete genealogy, which one of its members, the historian Prof.Philipp Jaffé (1819-1870) is supposed to have compiled and left to his nephew Moritz Jaffé, (1855-1930) did not materialise. This document must have been lost in the Holocaust. However, I obtained a short family history, written by Moritz Jaffé in Posen in 1888 and certainly based on family papers and other information, freely available to him at that time. Moritz, too, is sceptical about the claim of direct descent. He calls it cautiously a family "tradition". If Moritz Jaffé, an authority on German-Polish relations and author of the book "Die Stadt Posen unter preussischer Herrschaft" could not prove it one hundred years ago, how can our generation do so with the "iron curtain" between us and the past?

I only raise the question of direct descent from Rabbi Mordecai Jofe here, because I do not share the opinion of genealogists, who assume that all Jaffes stem from him. How is that possible, if some of them only adopted the surname "Jaffe" in the first half of the 19th century?

I completed the first version of "One Line of the Rabbi Mordecai Jaffe Pedigree" in 1980, followed by updated and revised versions in 1981, 1982 and 1983. The Leo Baeck Institute in New York, about 2 dozen descendants and myself have copies. The most recent one comprises 124 pages and has hardly any gaps in contrast to the "Miloslaw" Jaffe pedigree, on which whole families are still missing. There are other differences, of which I would like to point out a few:

The Rabbi Mordecai pedigree has many more orthodox Jews among its descendants up to the present day than the Miloslaw Jaffes. The majority of the latter are either assimilated or Christians. A great number of the former settled in Israel, whereas I do not know a single member of the latter who lives there. Only one descendant of the Rabbi Mordecai line stayed in Germany under Nazi regime, while an astonishing number of Miloslaw Jaffe descendants remained. (Compare page I, paragraph 2) of my introduction). Generally speaking, the attitude of the living descendants of the Rabbi Mordecai line towards Judaism is positive, compared with that of the Miloslaw Jaffes, who do not like to be reminded of their Jewish descent.

What both pedigrees have in common, is the impressive number

of descendants who distinguished themselves in various fields: high public office, industry and commerce, science, the arts, literature and law. The most famous member of "One Line of the Rabbi Mordecai Jaffe Pedigree" is the historian Prof. Philipp Jaffé (1819 Schwersenz-1870 Wittenberg), but there are other prominent figures, such as Geheimrat Bernhard Jaffé and some of his sons.

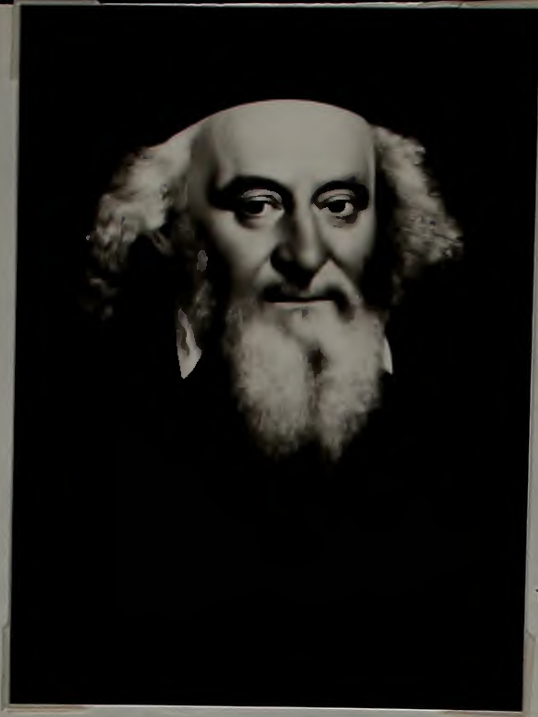
I have studied Philipp Jaffé's fascinating life story very closely and succeeded in tracing his nearest relatives and their living descendants, of whose existence the other members of this family had been unaware. I also discovered 133 personal letters, most of them in private possession, written by the historian between 1838 and 1866. One set of photocopies of these letters and also 10 biographies I donated to the archives of the Leo Baeck Institute and another to the "Monumenta Germaniae Historica" in Munich, whose collaborator Philipp Jaffé was from 1854 to 1863. The letters will be an important source for a new book on the history of the Monumenta; an enlargement of Prof. Philipp's photograph which I was also able to provide, is now hanging in the picture gallery of the Monumenta from which it has been missing for more than 100 years.

Finding the descendants of "One Line of the Rabbi Mordecai Jaffe Pedigree", scattered all over the world through the Holocaust, has been real detective work, taking up to 2 years in some cases. All the descendants I approached (I must have written hundreds of letters) are very appreciative of my work. Some enjoy being in touch with each other again after so many years, others look upon it as a kind of anniversary calendar, but I must confess that this is not exactly the aim of my labours! To me both the family trees I compiled mean more than a monotonous enumeration of names and dates. When studying their pages closely, the observant reader will detect many a human tragedy hidden behind the sober statistics. They also show clearly the historical, cultural and moral changes over the last centuries.

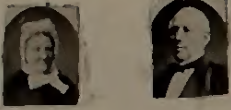
