Frederick Banting 1891-1941

Canadian scientist. Banting in 1920 became convinced of the existence of the substance now known as Insulin. A laboratory assistant, J. R. Macleod of the University of Toronto enabled Banting and Charles H. Best in 1921, to prepare an active anti-diabetic extract from the pancreas of the dog, purified by Dr. J. B. Collip. This was first used successfully on a patient in 1922, by Doctors W. R. Campbell and A. A. Fletcher. Banting and Macleod the Nobel Prize for Medicine in 1923 and was knighted in 1934. Born near Alliston, Ontario, he died in the crash of his aircraft in Newfoundland, on February 21, 1941.
