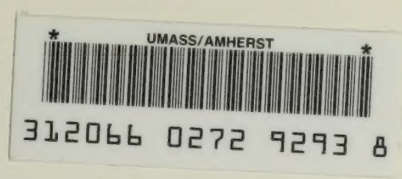
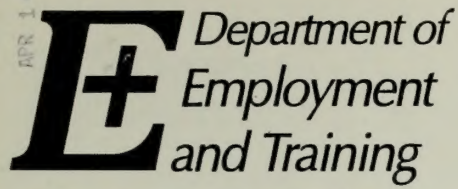

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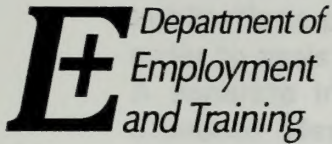

INTRODUCTION

The Massachusetts Department of Employment and Training has prepared a set of publications presenting labor market information for affirmative action programs in order to assist employers who are attempting to meet affirmative action obligations. A separate informational packet is available for Massachusetts and each of the Standard Metropolitan Statistical Areas as they existed at the time of the 1990 census.

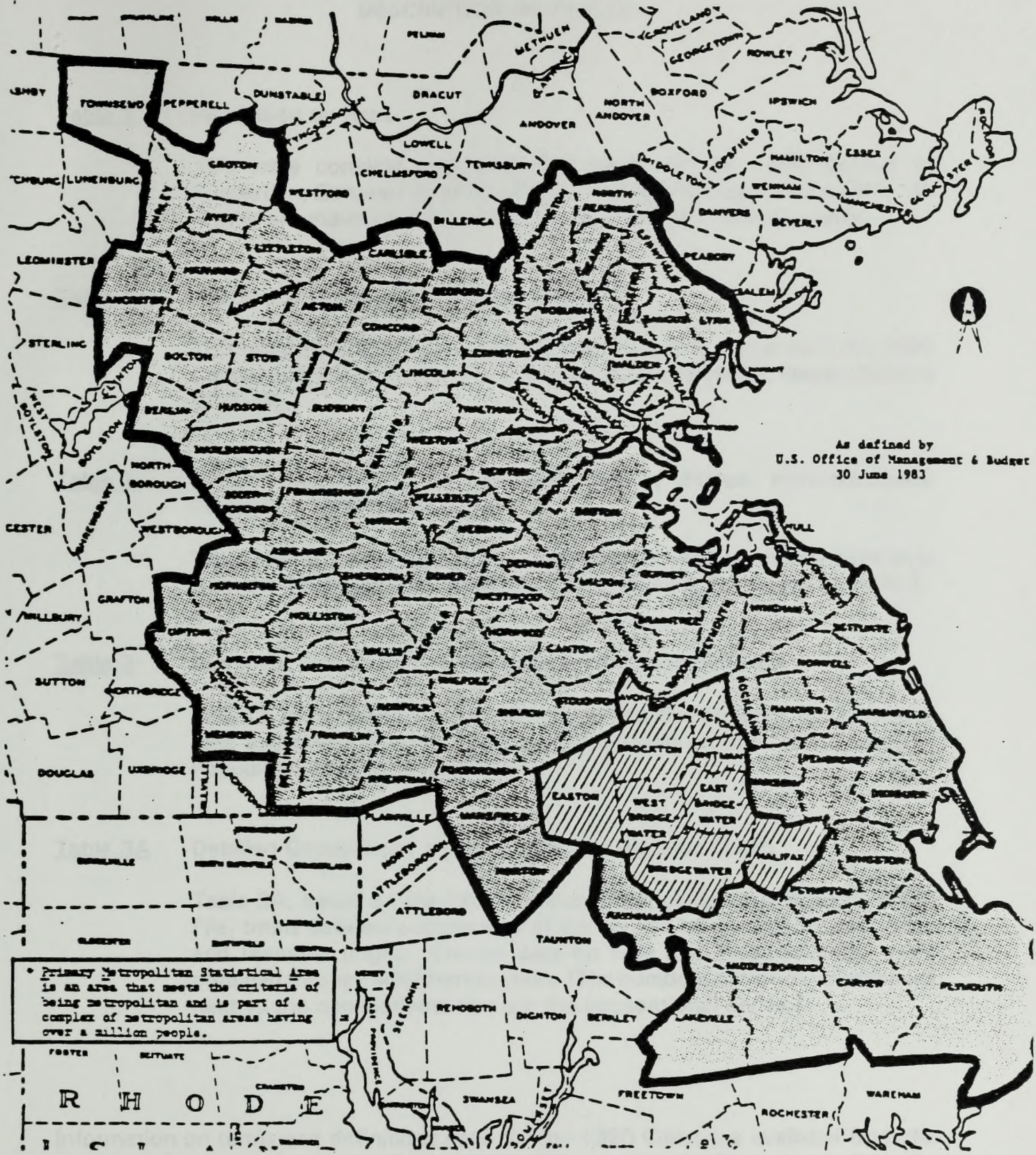

BOSTON, MA PMSA*

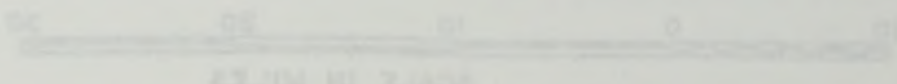


(BROCKTON, MA PMSA included)
