The S.A. Peace Corps won't get you to Zaire, Ghana, Brazil, Peru, or Vietnam. It will get you to Maxton, North Laurinburg Elementary School, or Scotland County Memorial Hospital.

Before the Kennedy Administration gave birth to the new famous Peace Corps, S.A. had an organization with the same name (they copied us!) with some of the same concerns but with less exotic and closer-to-home concerns. It is an all volunteer group (no draft) seeking to meet some local needs through community involvement. As we swing into spring, we need you to help in one of the following:

Breakfast Program: Feeds 150 hungry children five mornings a week in a local school. This is the biggest program in operation now. We need another 10-12 helpers in this one. See George Conn or call Ext. 316.

Tutoring: Some tutoring programs are already in action. The need is greater than our personnel now. We can put everybody/anybody to work in this. See George Conn or call Ext. 316.

Hospital Visitation: Visiting and entertaining with both children and Senior Citizens. Flexible schedule. See or call Martha Jane Helms, Ext. 249, Concord.

Probation Officer Assistant: Developing one to one relationship with young persons on probation. Especially need men for this one. See George Conn or call Ext. 316.

Girl Scouts: Working with a troop of primarily economically and culturally deprived girls. See Susan Radar, Ext. 362.

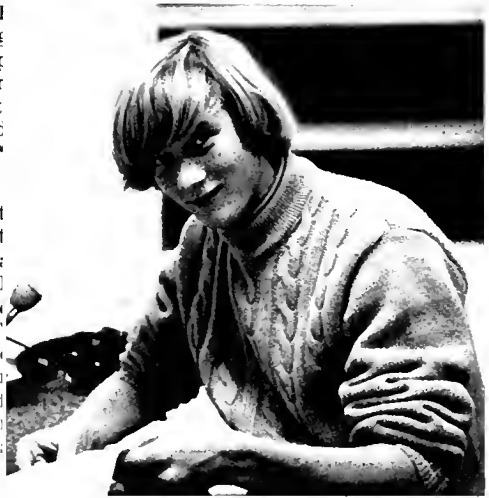

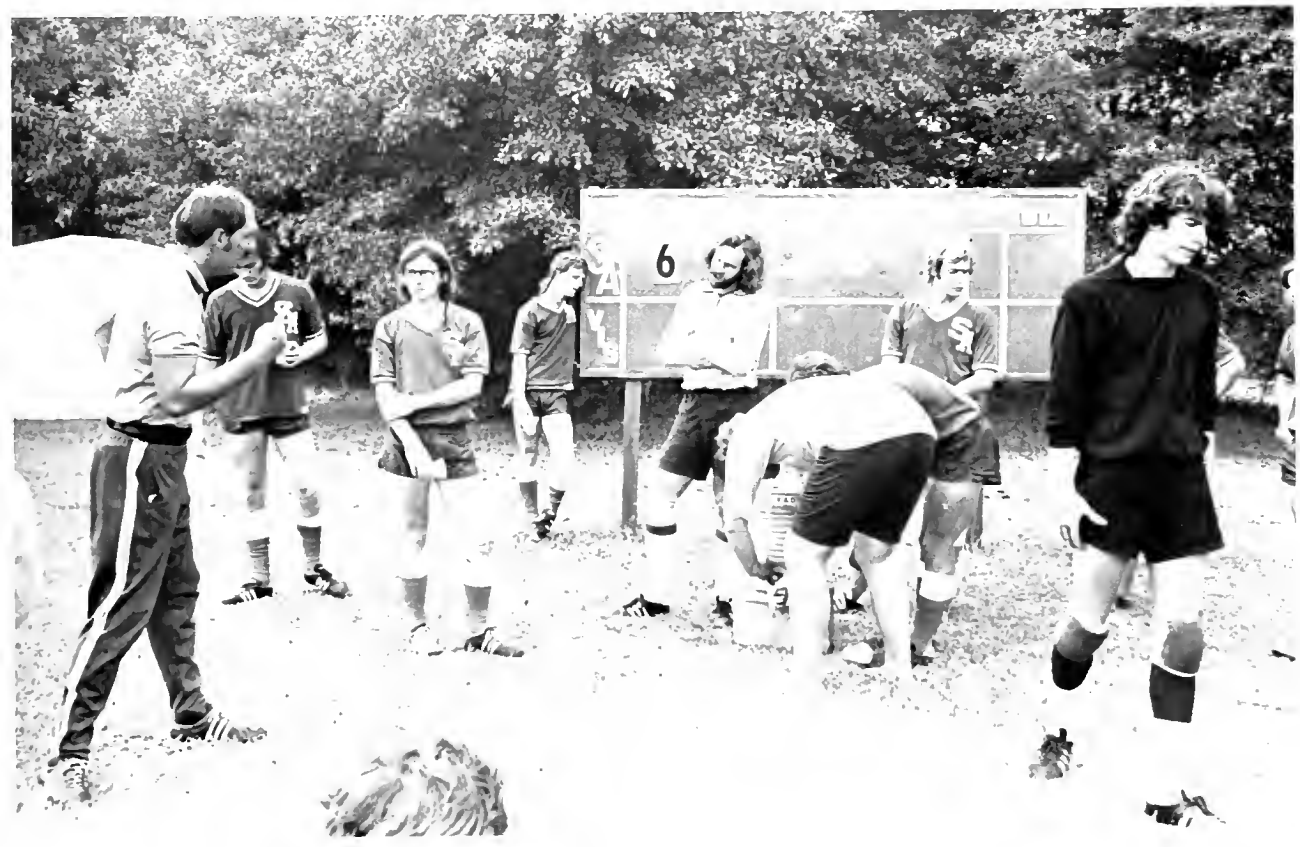

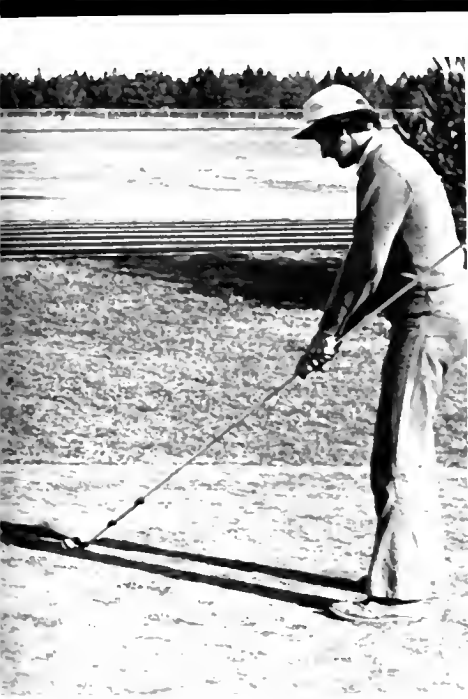

The dome is the limit as infinitesimal calculus approaches obsolescence, and since gravity is to dome struts as organization's to man's creativity, the 170 and 168 degree angles on the inside of the dome might symbolize mathematics as it is known today, and since Buckminster Fuller's ideas are to nature as time and space are to a continuum, the branches of the dome itself might represent the barrier which separates and defines man's most recent architectural attempt to understand nature via geodesic geometry, and the roots of nature's designs may stem from the substitution of chords for arcs. We have found the dome to be a viable, adequate structure for differentiating order from chaos. Indeed, these words on the dome border on the irrational.

Black Mountain College Festival Spring 1974

Black Mountain College. Founded 1933. Closed 1956. In its short life in the mountains of North Carolina, Black Mountain College blazed a new trail in experimental education in America. A small, close community of people living and working together, Black Mountain College at its height had less than 100 students and faculty. In its last years fewer than 20 people could be found there at any one time. Yet it managed to attract a faculty of international importance. And its alumni include more poets, novelists, painters, potters, musicians, and film makers of significance than any other small college in the country.

Black Mountain College. A symbol of exploration and discovery. Explorations in education . . . self-directed study; non-directed learning; student-led courses. Explorations in living . . . communal living; faculty-student work crews on the farm and constructing the buildings on the campus. And discoveries . . . the first happening, staged by John Cage. Buckminster Fuller's first geodesic dome. Robert Rauschenburg's all white paintings.

New music. Op art. Pop art. Projective verse. Found poetry. Their origins were at Black Mountain College.

In the spring of 1974, some of the explorers returned. Week by week, from early February through the end of April, they came to St. Andrews to celebrate the strengths of Black Mountain. As each left we learned more about those strengths, but we also discovered our own strengths.

Buckminster Fuller once said that man does not create. To create is to add something to the universe. Since nothing can be added, creation is impossible. What man does is discover. And it was man's unique power to discover (rather than to create) that the Black Mountain College Festival celebrated.
