September 18, 1999

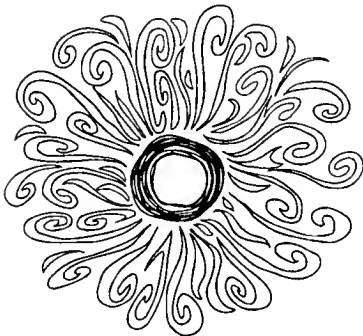
