Dear Aunt Mary

I wrote you a few lines yesterday and as I have a chance, will write you a few more to day though I have nothing to tell you of primary importance Mrs Tipton called yesterday but both Caroline & I was out Debora saw her however & said she was highly exalted. Caroline put a border round the room which has much improved the looks of it. Maria spent the afternoon here & Sarah Ann took tea here, as she chanced in. She is very well & in fine spirits. Mrs B is much the same; not so comfortable as she was at one time. We all just Sarah Ann went to the A. S. Concert in the evening. The meeting was a large one & perfectly orderly. The music was by a choir of assured children. They looked as pretty as could be. Brother Wright presided and did well as usual. Several others prayed and spoke some and lastly Bro Gulliver spoke in a most undaunted manner. He hailed the Faneuil Hall meeting as a most favourable circumstance & decided that affairs were never more promising. This, from the responding decision comforted us much. There is to be an A. S. meeting a week from Wed. whether the brethren Thompson & Cole will be present. I cannot say. Maria is writing to day to Thompson, stirring him up to action. My cold seems a little better. Sarah Mitchell has come. We like Margaret very well. Mr Beards & the girls called yesterday, just for a call. Seemed rather as named I believe. None of the boarders have come. I met Mr Kingsbury in the street this morning just coming from our house. We shook hands & I said to him almost involuntarily "I did not see you while I was down". He appeared perfectly as usual & offered to take this. We have not, as yet heard from Cambridge. Caroline met Helike yesterday, & vowed to him she cut her
