that soon after our late Anniversary, one of our Aldermen stated in a meeting of their Board that he heard Abby Kelly Foster say that she would be glad that the slaves would cut their masters throats and that she would like to see them dabbling in their masters blood.

I do not recollect the precise language but I think I have given the substance of it. I have been expecting to see this slander, for I have no doubt but it is a slander, contradicted from under Abby's own hand. It appears to me that this

ought to be done and that too in strong
and unequivocal ~~long~~ terms - and
the sooner the better -
