ciple you recommend.

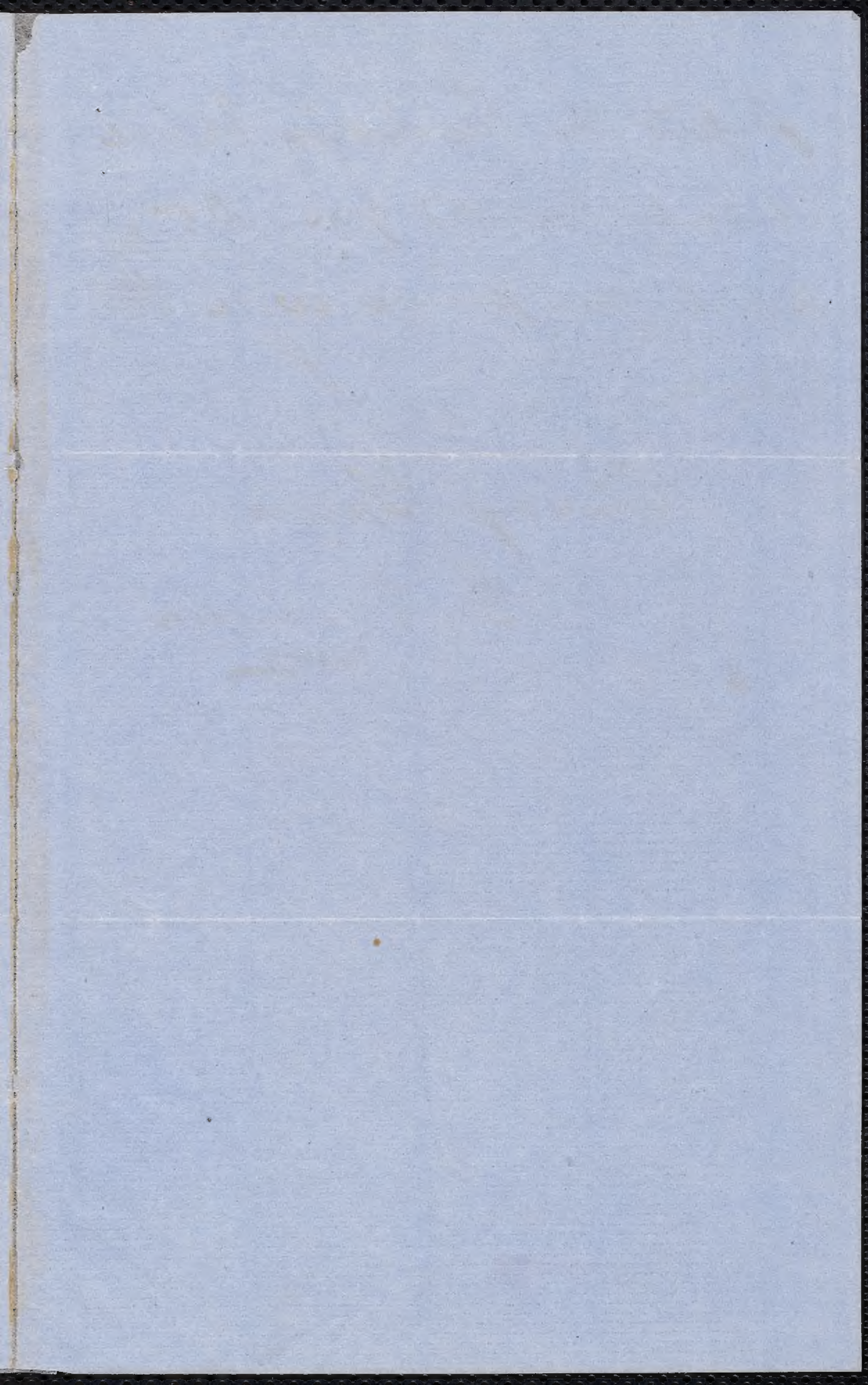
I have you a number
