intend to go, & how many days to remain.

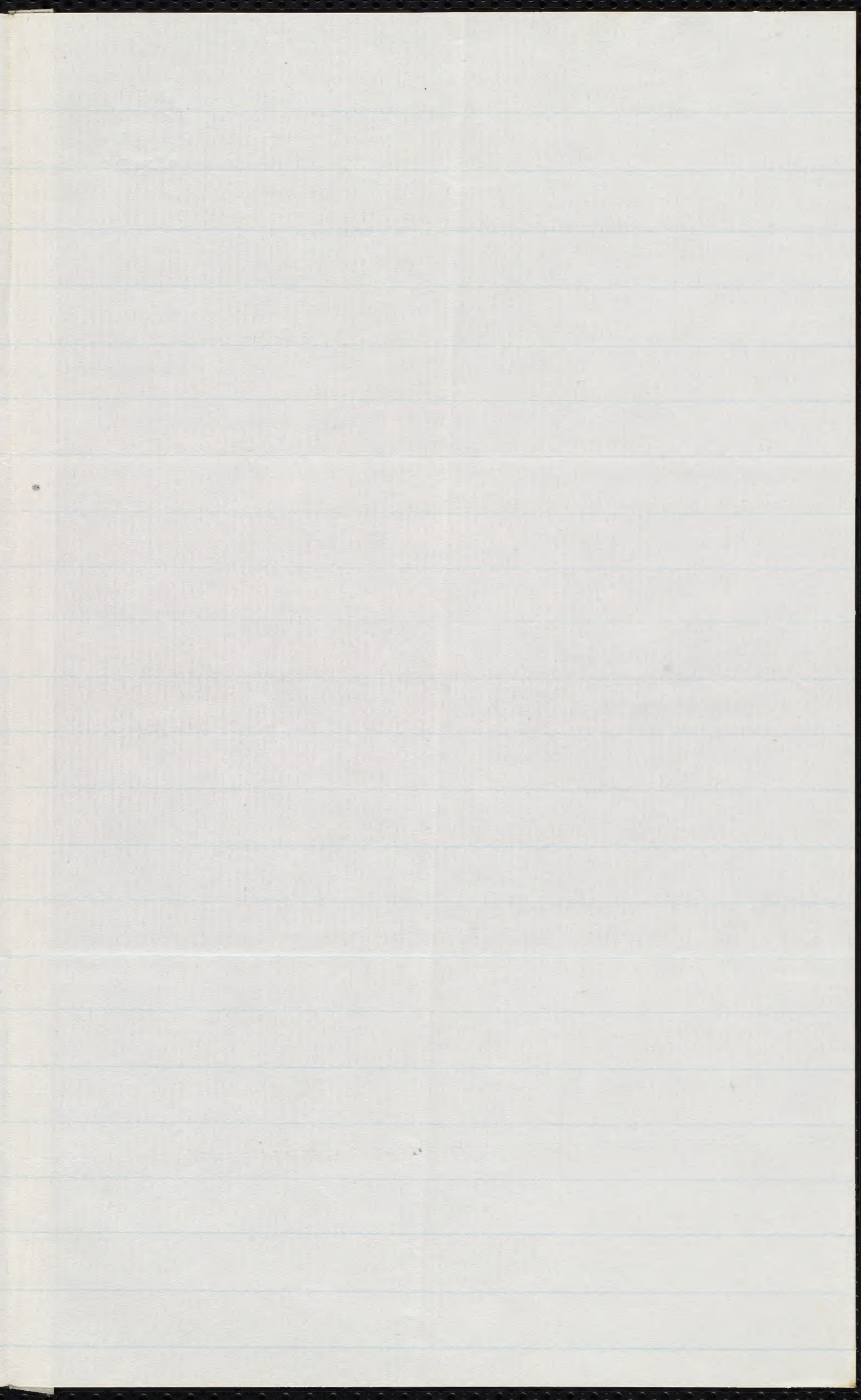
Doubtless some place can be found
