Esteemed Friend I received
while in Weybridge from some one I
don't know who, - your note requesting
me in behalf of the Weymouth Antislavery
Society, to deliver one, or two lectures
in Weymouth or its vicinity, previous
to my leaving for England.

I will comply with your request, Providence
permitting. And if you please you
may announce through the Liberator
that I will lecture in the following
towns - in the following order.

Weymouth	7 th	August
Hingham	8 th	August
Hingston -	9 th	August
Duxbury	10 th	August

I expect to leave for England 15th Aug.
I shall probably celebrate West India
emancipation ^{1st August} in Buffalo N.Y.
and return from ~~Weymouth~~ to Boston,
