Dear Madam

I forwarded to Liverpool on
the 12th inst, one box sent to my care from Sam Wigham
Edinburgh, to be shipped for you by the Steamer
which sails for Boston tomorrow, which I hope will
reach you safe - it is addressed in full with your
name, 21 Cornhill Boston, for convenience of Customs
entry it is marked ~~£1~~ \$1 - is entered as Millinery
value £40 - Mr. Wigham will no doubt have
written you with a List of the contents, having advised
me so - in the acknowledgment of the receipt of
this box in the Liberator & Bazaar Gazette, please
be particular to mark it as sent by Sam Wigham,
Edinburgh, not to mention my name regarding it,
thus prevent any misapprehension, as to the sender.

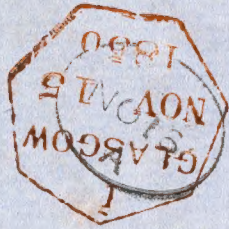
It has been found impossible to send off the
Box from Glasgow until the Steamer from Liverpool on
the 30th when it will be sent - my sisters cannot
as yet say what may be the value, but that it will
be pretty fair, & articles much same description as
formerly, tho' it has been considerably injured
by parties who have ~~by~~ set up a new female
Anti Slavery Society here on acct of the want of
orthodoxy in our American friends, & have endeavoured
to withdraw contributions - in this they have been
assisted by a coloured man named Dr Cunningham,
who is said to be a Minister of a Presbyterian
Church at New York, & has suggested the New
York Vigilance Committee as the proper party
to be supported. I intend writing Mr Garrison
about this affair; My sisters desire to be remembered

to yourself, Mr. Garrison & other friends
