Your very
welcome letter was received
today. I called upon Sarah
Pugh, to communicate its
contents to her and her cous-
ins who constitute that house-
hold. Sarah was not at home,
but her cousins made with
me the arrangement that, if
it is agreeable to you & Wed-
dell, you will go to Dr. Child's,
on your arrival in this city;
and they will meet you there
in the evening, and, with great
pleasure, escort you to their
house. Dr. & Mrs. Child will
expect you to dinner on Wed-
nesday; & they have invi-

led a good many persons
to meet you, at tea. I would
give S. Pugh & her cousins
great pleasure to receive you
both, at their house, im-
mediately on your arrival,
but they make the other
arrangement in order to give
you better opportunity for
rest; and, also, that Mrs.
Child may not be disappoint-
ed. If you bring a trunk with
you, you can send it, with-
out trouble to yourself, and
with perfect safety, by the
Express Company, (whose a-
gent you will find on the car
or boat) to Miss Pugh's No.
10 14 Green St.

Dr. Child's house is No.
634 Race St. If you come
from Bristol by rail-road,

our city passengers cars, which you will find at the depot, awaiting the arrival of your train, will bring you down 6th street to Race St. at which point you will be within a few steps of Dr. Child's house. Your only care need be, not to pass Race St. If you come from Bristol in the boat, your best plan will be to take a car on Front St. which will connect with another at Walnut & 8th streets, which will take you to 8th & Race streets, at which point you will not be far from Dr. Child's. I make these suggestions lest you should not be accompanied from Bristol by any of our friends there. If you should be so, they will, of course, be unnecessary. Not

knowing at what point or
at what hour you will arrive,
neither Mr. McKim or Dr. Putt
will be able to meet you.
