the half of her customary

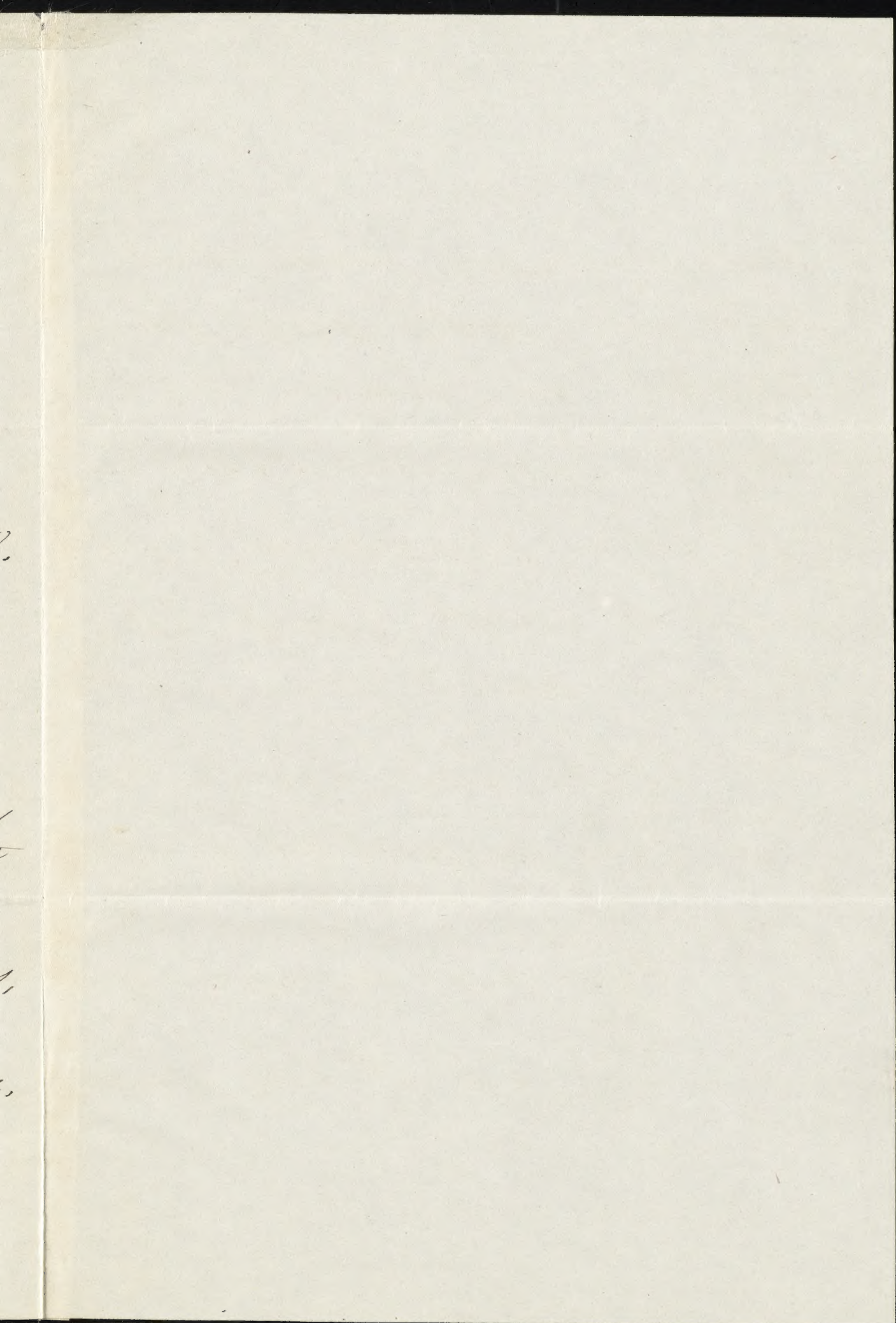
subscription card has
