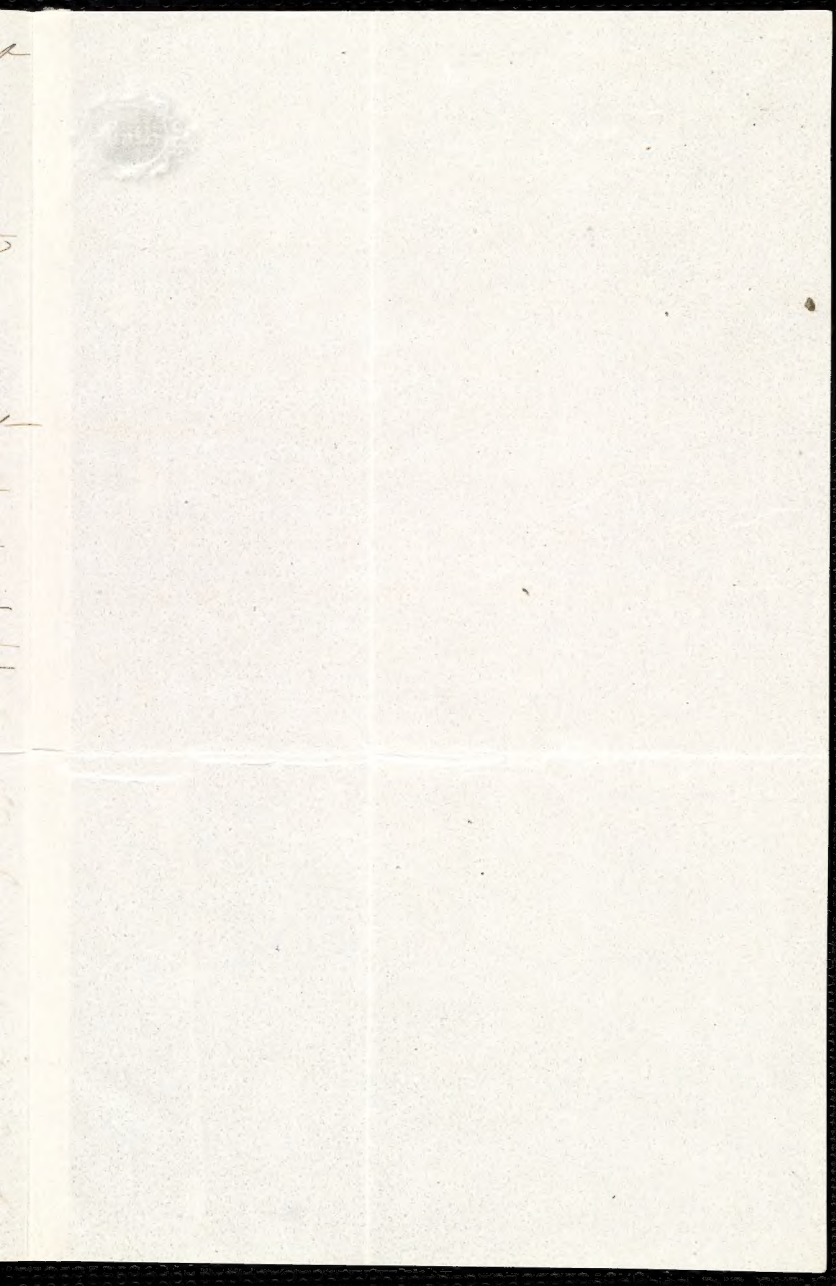


My dear Miss Weston
