

Boston May. 8th 1835

Boylston Street

My dear mother

I was, very
glad indeed this morning to get my
silk gown for I have suffered for want
of it. We are all very well excepting Emma
who is very feeble & poorly. She is troubled
with the headache, just those spring complaints
she had last year at this time. If it clears
off she may come with W. K., but I think she
had better not if it rains. She must I think
take an emetic. I had a very uncomfortable
day wednesday, for we expected Sullivan
was to lecture in the evening, & we could
find out nothing about it, but just as
night Maria came to say that it was put
off until the 20th & it was voted that
no ladies should be admitted. Mr. Gleitscher
thinks it almost shameful thing Caroline
walked down in town with him & had
a long talk. Maria is very busy about Mrs
Child. The facts are these Mrs Child is writing
a book & she can't go on with it, because the
directors of the Athenaeum library have
revoked the permission which they gave
her some years ago to take out what
books she chose. As these books she must

have, or give up her book. So Maria has
taken it in hand. The price of a share is
\$100. & Maria has raised \$75 since yesterday
morning, so we think she will succeed.
We are all invited to the Baylies to night
last night we were at Maria's. Mr Henry
Winsor was there & the Chapmans.
Warren has not been able to get
the tobacco yet - & you dont say
whether he must get the potatoes
at 75 cents for bushel. Let me
know whether he must give
that for them if he cant get
them cheaper. How does Lissy
do, give my love to her
It seems like heaven
with out her.
