

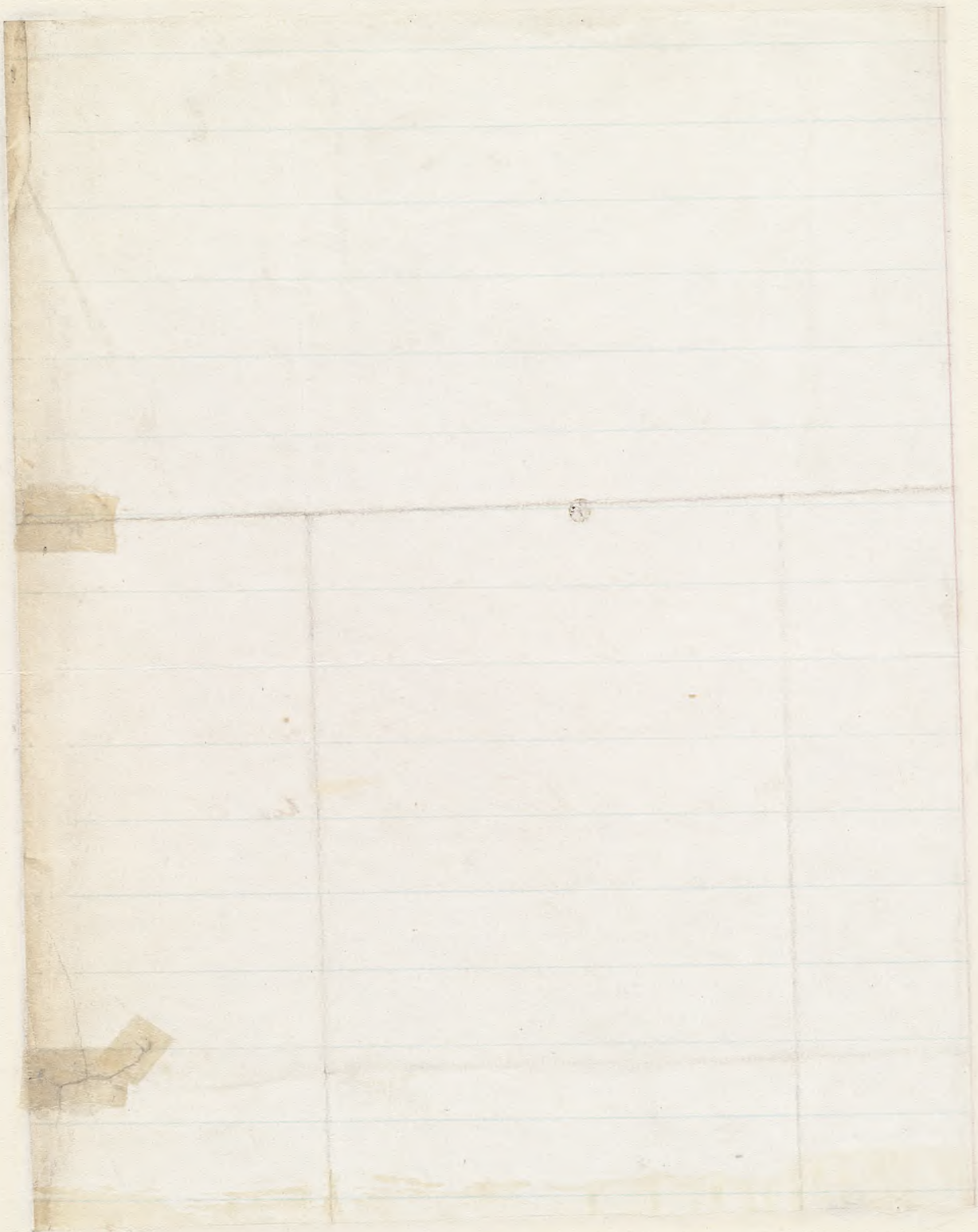
Rochester: November 9th 1869.
